

What is the primary technology you have access to in order to participate in your college coursework?





# **Students' Plan for Fall Enrollment**


What concerns do you have about taking courses online? (Mark all that apply)

# Students' Concerns about Attending Classes On Campus


What concerns do you have about taking courses on campus? (Mark all that apply)

# Students' Needs to Feel Safe On Campus


What precautions would vou like to see in order to feel safe on campus? (Mark all that apply)

Have you accessed any of the virtual online support services? (Mark all that apply)







# Employee's Group & Status




# Employees' Level of Concern About Returning to Campus

What are vour concerns, if any, about coming back to work? (Mark all that apply)




- Students and employees shared the most frequent five concerns.
- The first two most frequent concerns are the same.
- Differences in ranking are for the other three most frequent:

Concern	Students	Employees
Protecting the health of someone else	4th	3 <sup>rd</sup>
Clear safety requirements	3rd	5 <sup>th</sup>
Availability of sanitizer	5th	4th

# Employees' Needs to Feel Safe On Campus

- The first two most frequent concerns are the same for students and employees.

# Recommendations

- Wait until the end of Spring semester to determine if students' responses trends change.
- Wait until the end of May to determine if employees' responses trends change.
- When setting College annual priorities to guide 2020-21 budget decisions, consider:
  Main challenges faced by students
  - Students' concerns about online coursework
  - Students' concerns regarding attending classes on campus and needs to feel safe on campus
  - Employees' concerns regarding returning to campus to work and needs to feel safe on campus
- Review online support services for students to evaluate efficiencies as most of them are underused.
