In the 2017 **Vision for Success**, the California Community College Chancellor’s Office and Board of Governors established system-wide goals for improving student outcomes.

According to **AB 1809**, districts must adopt local performance goals that are aligned with the Vision for Success goals; are measurable numerically; and specify the timeline for improvement.

The goals presented in the infographic correspond to the El Camino College District local goals that will help contribute to reaching those set by the Chancellor’s Office.

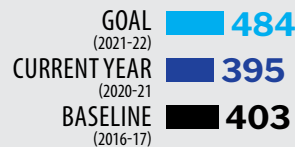

1C Increase students who earn a degree or certificate by **20%**



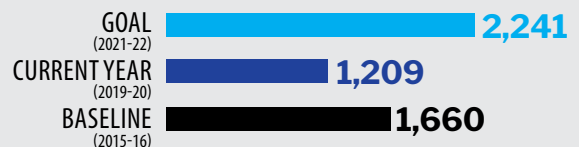

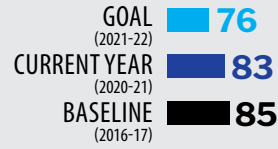
