

The Superintendent/President shall ensure that the El Camino Community College District implements a comprehensive integrated planning process that involves all the institution's constituent groups (students, faculty, staff, and administrators), the stakeholders from the broader community (e.g., industry partners, high schools, alumni, etc.), and is informed by institutional research involving an internal and external environmental scan. The comprehensive integrated planning process results in a Comprehensive Integrated Plan (CIP).

The Comprehensive Integrated Plan shall include plans required by law. The Superintendent/President shall submit those plans to the Board for which Board approval is required by Title 5.

The Superintendent/President shall regularly inform the Board about the status of the comprehensive integrated planning process and the various plans.

The Superintendent/President shall ensure the Board has an opportunity to assist in developing the institutional mission and goals for the comprehensive integrated plan.
