



## Completion of College Council Goals



Provide orientation to all members of CC on its purpose, goals, and expectations. Annually evaluate the CC's effectiveness

Complete/continue development & regular updates to legally advised & required policies & procedures, placing priority on legally required ones

Support the Accreditation Peer Review Team visit, and the ECC

Be informed of Pres. Adv. Comm. on Race and Equity work reaffirmation of accreditation of & discuss strengthening campus equity gaps using data disaggregation & enhanced inclusion & diversity. Explore opportunities for inclusionary cross-campus dialogue

Receive regular updates from the COVID-19 Task Force & facilitate campus climate, reduction of student communications that inform CC constituents on actions taken in response to COVID-19 pandemic

Ensure CC is informed of initiatives such as: GP & Equity Outcomes, ASO initiatives, technology modern., sustainability plan progress, enrollment operation & management, SP implementation & monit., FMP developments, impact of fiscal developments on campus

Strengthen campus communications by creating a CC communications plan to inform stakeholders on major CC discussions & recommendations


#### **Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents**

## Committee's Functioning Findings




#### **Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents**
