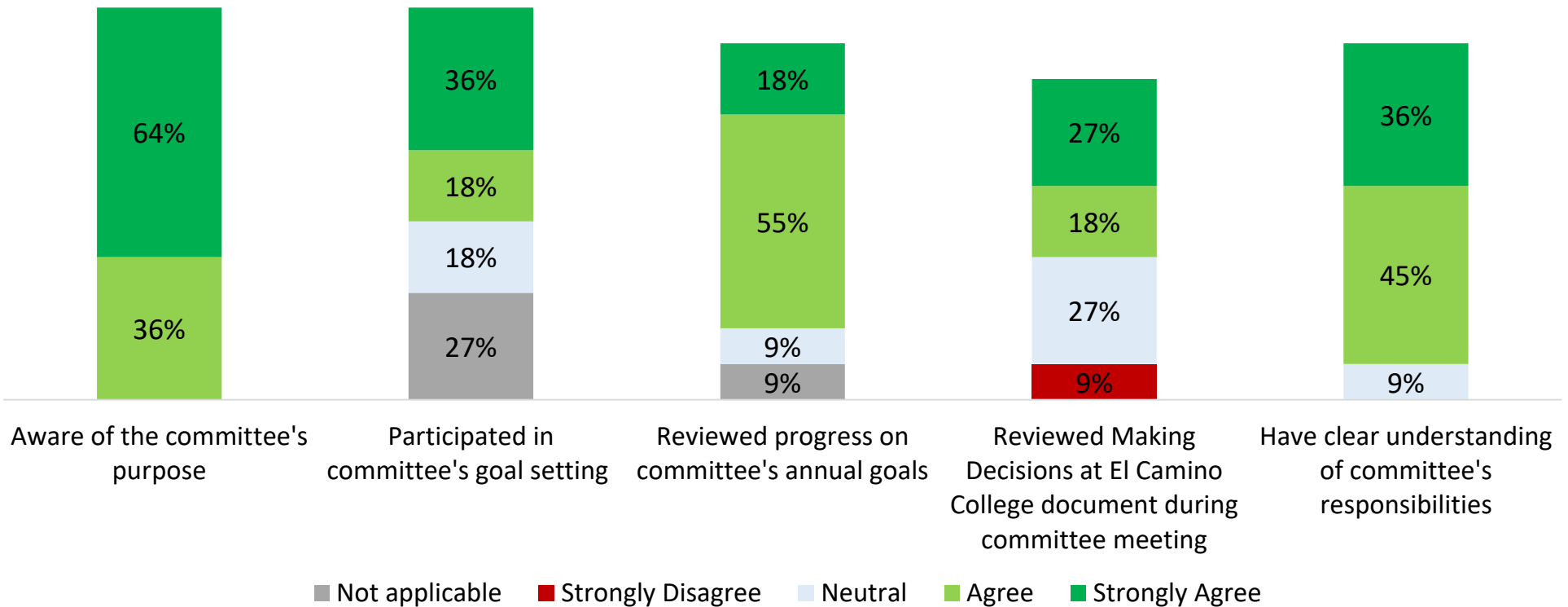

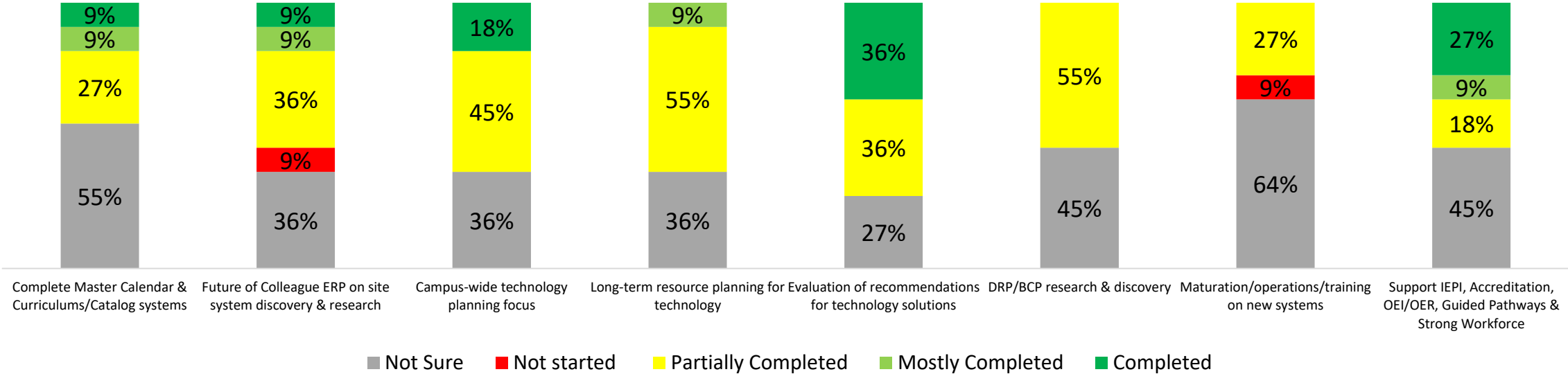

# Completion of Technology Committee Goals

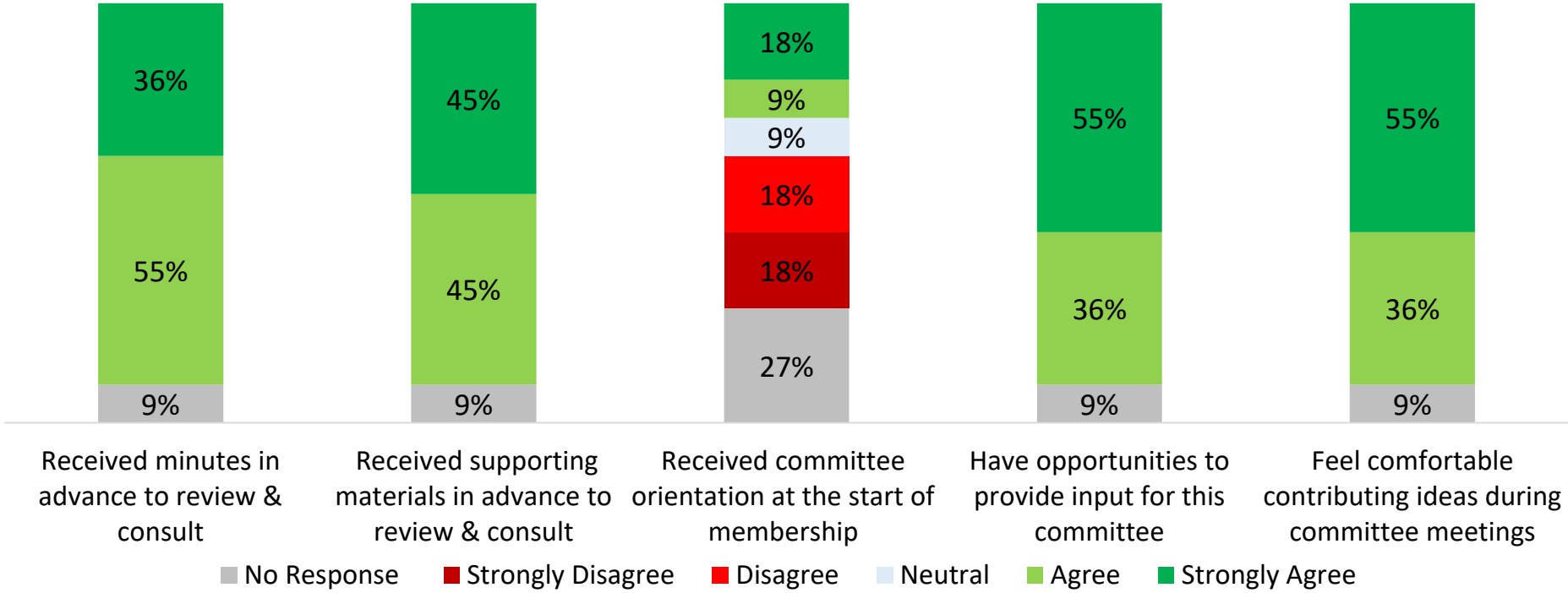


# Purpose, Goals & Tasks Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents

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- Defined strategic goals and set up priorities for next fiscal year.
- Worked towards the original purpose of the committee: To review, advise on, and authorize new technology purchases for the campus.
- Helped in making decisions about what technology is to be used on campus.
- Centralized all new hardware & software requests through the Committee.
- Formalized a process to acquiring technology campus wide.
- Established policies.

# Functioning Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents

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- Created working groups for each strategic goal and priorities.
- Adapted to the technical needs of the pandemic.
- Developed and used a consistent process for evaluating new software (and hardware) solutions including SaaS.

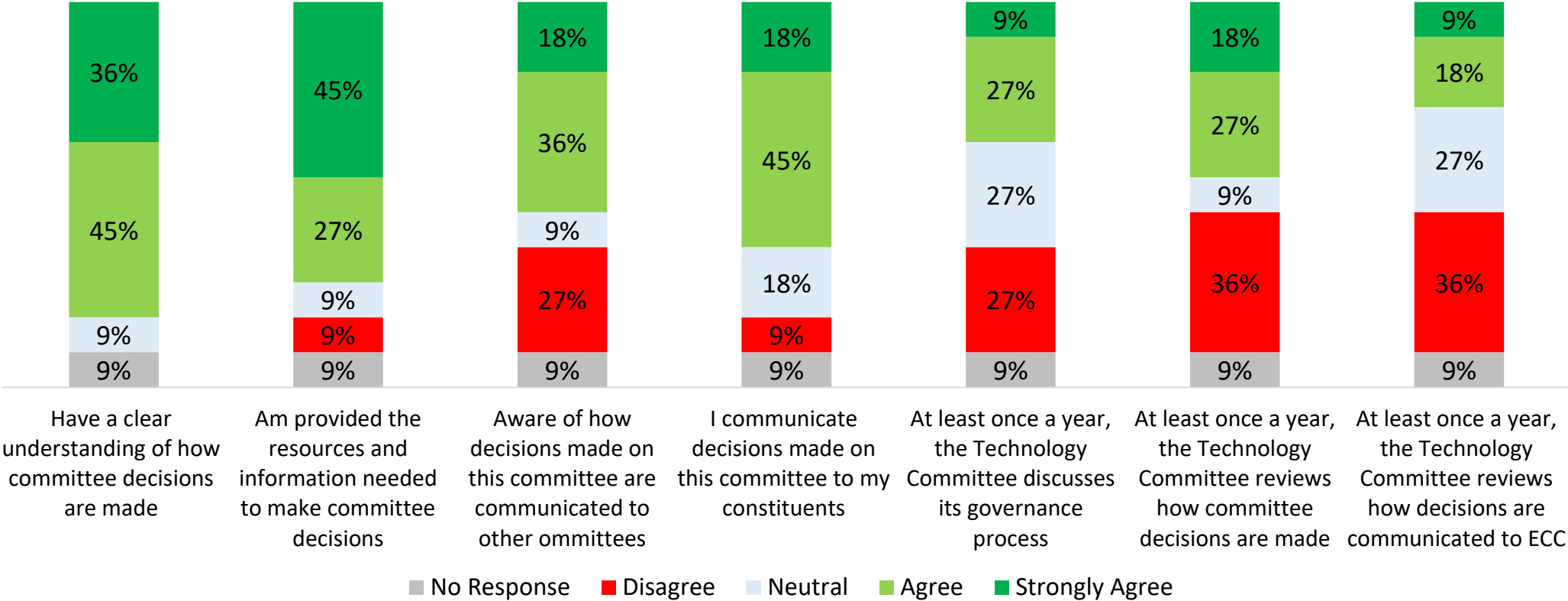
# Functioning Improvements Mentioned by Respondents

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- Extend meeting length from 60 to 90 minutes
- Better monitor working groups activities and progress
- Limit meeting time allocated to new hardware & software purchase requests to spend more time talking about innovating and transforming the organization through the use of technology
- Have consistent student representation in the committee
- Expand faculty representation in the committee
