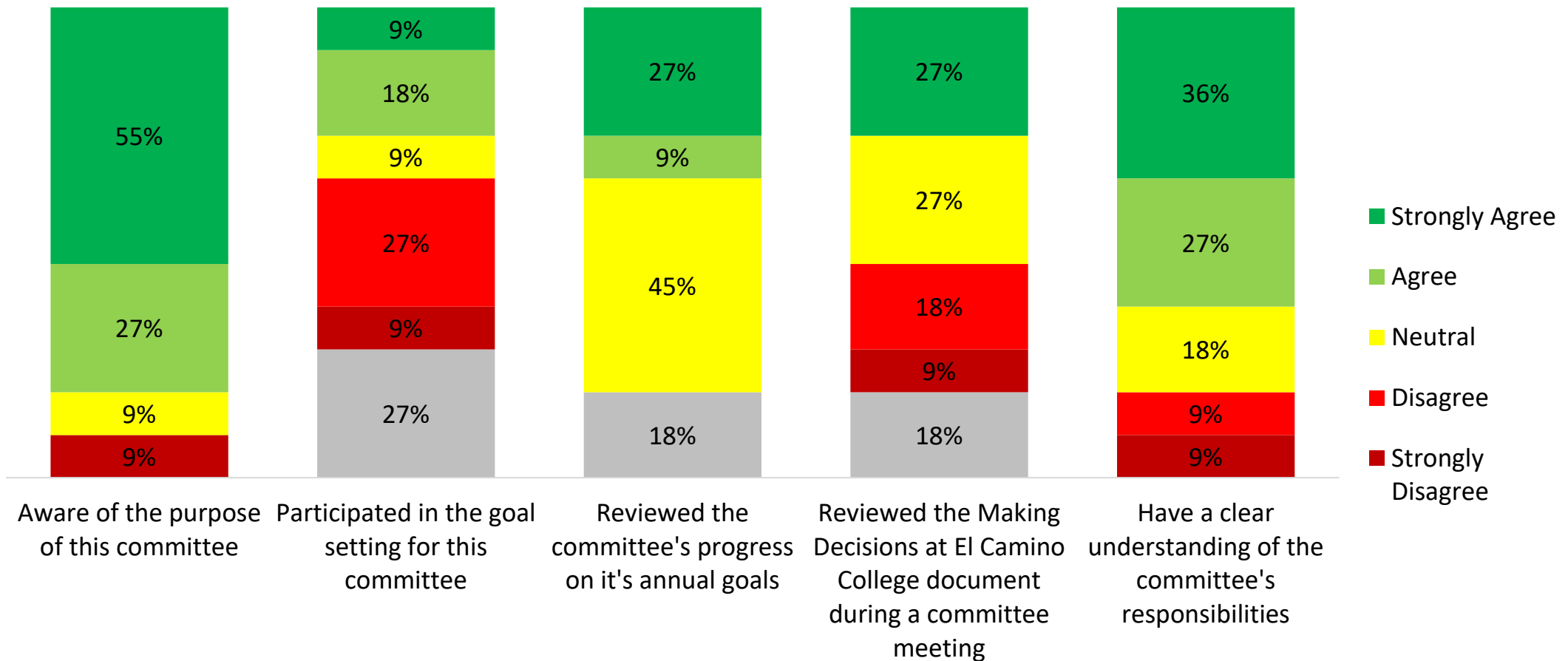

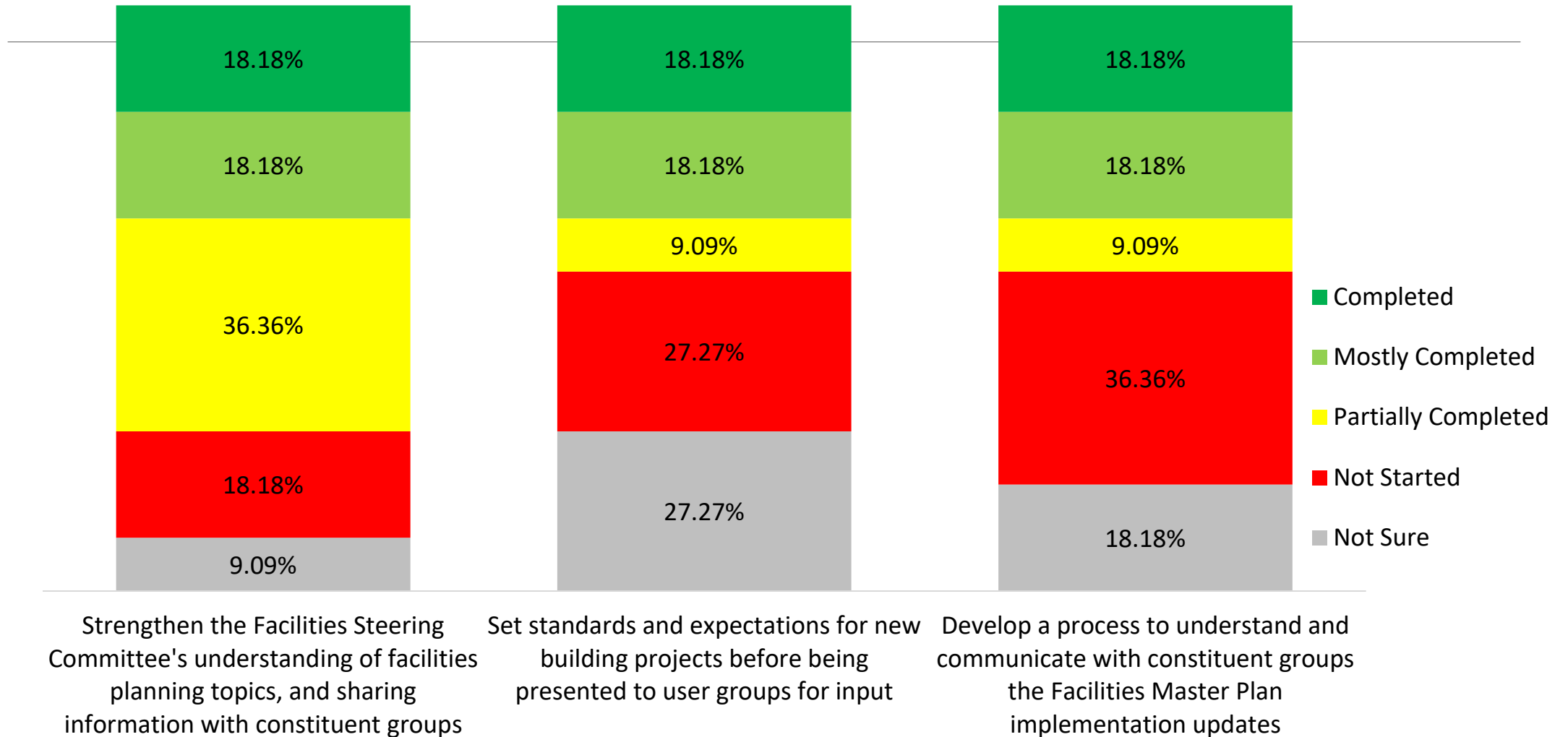

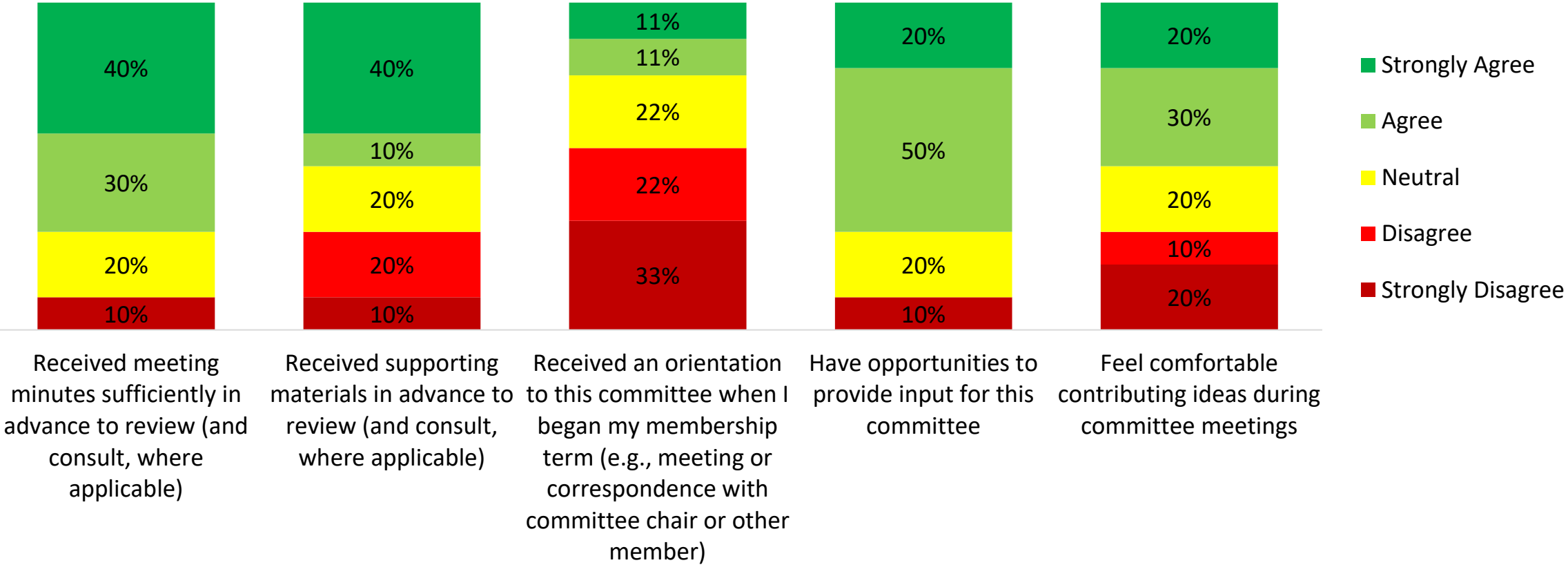
Purpose, Goals & Tasks Findings



Completion of Goals Findings



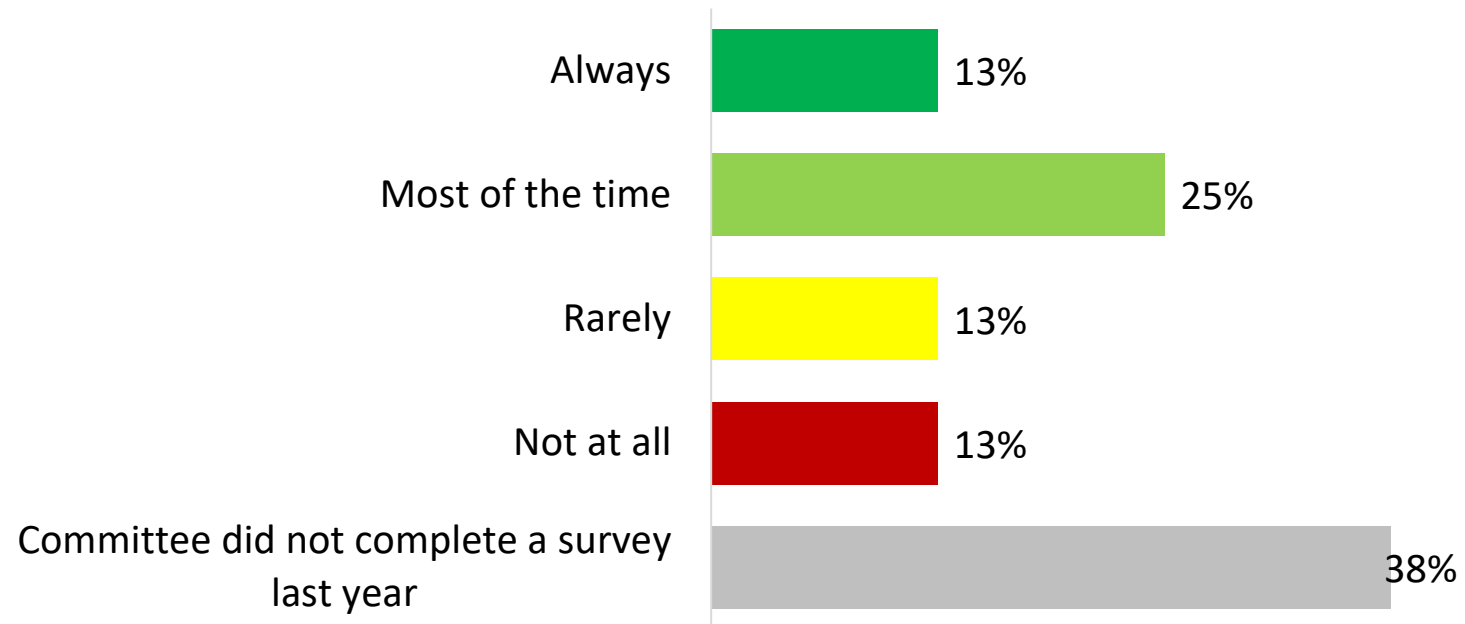
Committee's Functioning Findings



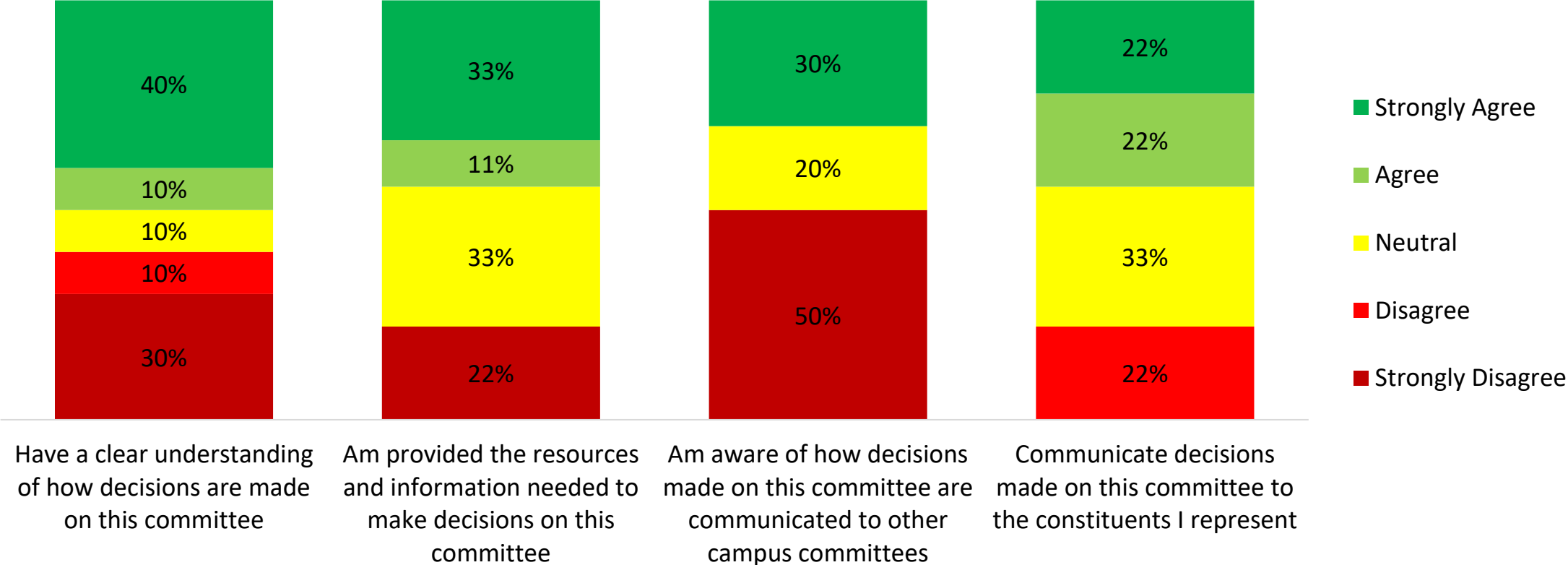

Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents

- Adding some proposed projects based on members' input.
- None that I can think of.

Improvements Mentioned by Respondents

- Orientation to the committee.
- Finding a purpose for the committee. It seemed the committee was there just to listen to what the college had already decided about facilities on campus. The committee is just TOLD what has already happened.
- There is a strong lack of willingness to truly listen to the opinions and ideas of committee members.
- We need to have a comprehensive minute and be truthful to our readers.
- Set standards and expectations for new building projects before presenting to user groups for input. This is one of the committee's stated goals. This never happened!
- Responsibilities of the VP: Does the VP make his own decisions on how monies are to be directed for each facility project and then report back to the committee? Or is it his responsibility to present options being considered and ask for input?
