



#### 3-Year Trend Response Rate






## 3-Year Trend for Purpose, Goal-Setting & Tasks Findings




### Completion of Annual Priorities Findings




## 3-Year Trend for Functioning Findings





In the last year, how often did the Technology Committee use results from prior survey to plan committee work for the upcoming year?




In the last year, how often did the Technology

### Accomplishments Mentioned by Respondents

- Rollout of Multi-factor Authentication across campus and constituent groups was highly effective in ensuring data security on campus.
- Procurement process led by the CTO was exemplary in evaluating software, its purpose, and its necessity on campus.
- Development of technology procurement process flow chart
- Development and refinement of communication plans around technology procurement for the campus
- Campus Technology Plan update
- Movement of student computer system
- Movement of Wi-Fi system
- Development of email acceptable use policy
- Work on several essential Administrative Procedures

### Improvements Mentioned by Respondents

- New committee members may benefit from more orientation resources accessible
  following orientation and the first committee meeting. Resources would help members to
  know how the Technology committee fits within the larger structure of the campus, and
  the procurement process.
- Add two new sections to the committee's agenda:
  - Academic services systems
  - Administrative/non-academic systems
- Improve committee's meeting schedule to ensure consistent student representation and opportunities for student voices to be heard.
