

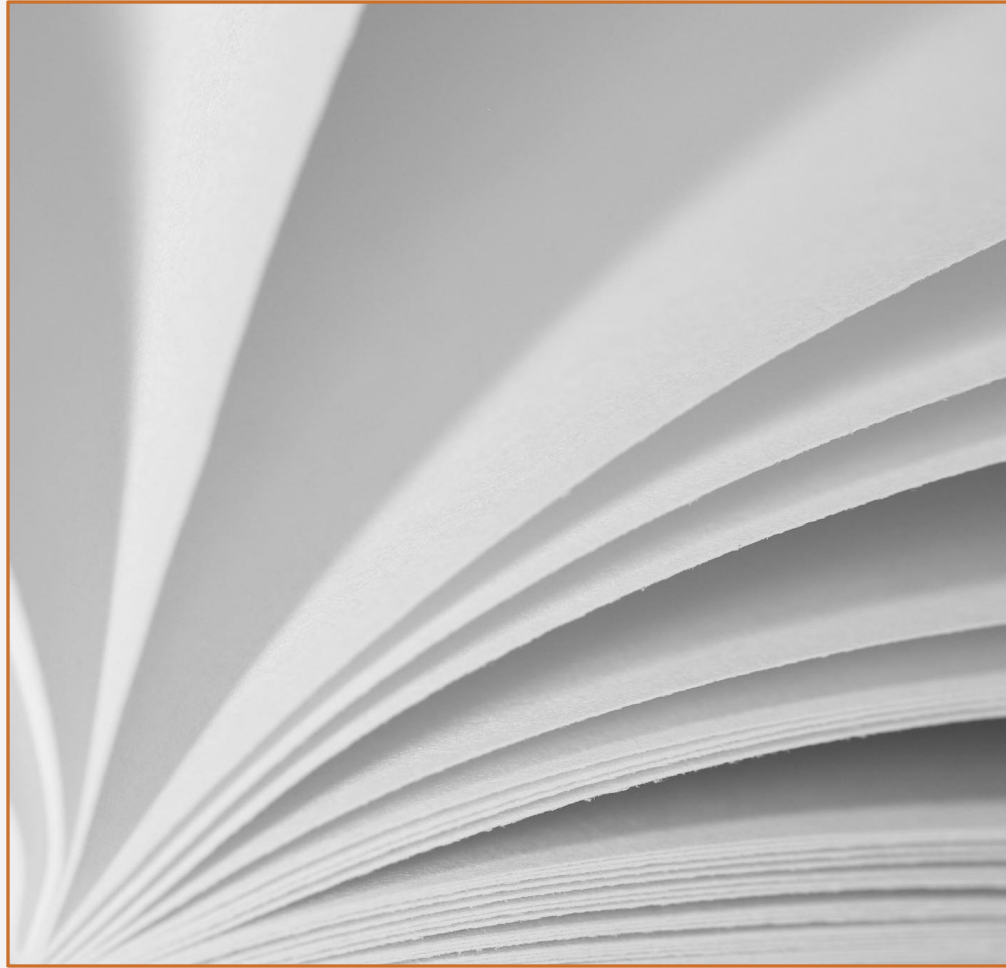


Academic Senate Meeting
