


Reminders



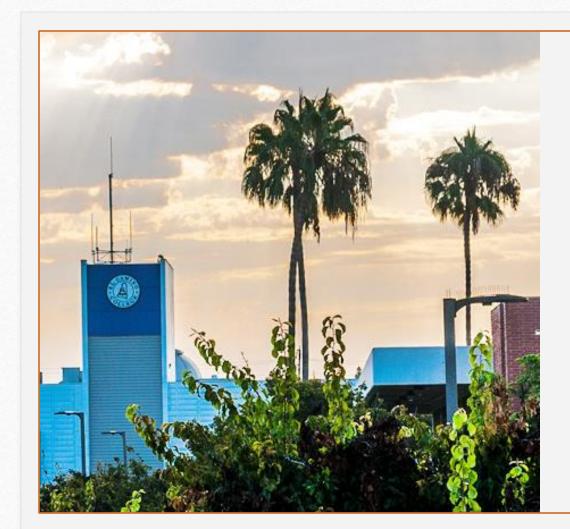
