


Reminders





- <u>Copilot</u> with commercial data protection is now available for colleges(copilot.microsoft.com)
 - Copilot is Microsoft's generative AI
 - It is the data protected version (*not* the Pro or the Copilot for Microsoft 365 versions).
 - Uses Open AI's DALL-E 3 (images) and GPT-4 (text)
 - Data protection means: the chat history is not saved and it's not available to users or the organization. Third party plugins are not supported to prevent commercial data from being sent to external providers.
