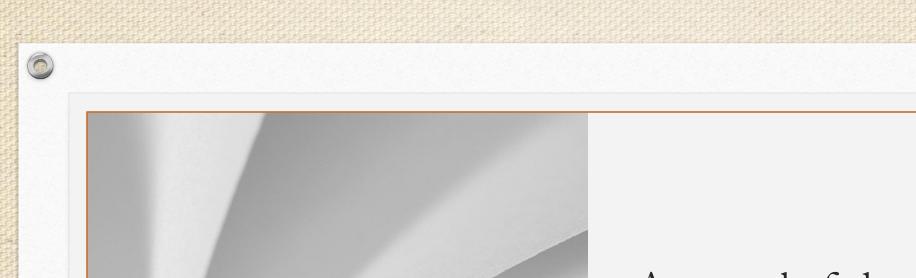


Reminders
