4. ASSOCIATE DEGREE TASK FORCE

L. Suekawa reported that a subcommittee of the CCC is being established as a result of revisions to Title 5 that will affect the local GE pattern. L. Suekawa and VP Lopez will be heading the Associate Degree Task Force and request that one representative from each academic division take part. The task force will focus on the Ethnic Studies degree, as well as review the two associate degree patterns (A.A. and A.S.). Contact L. Suekawa and E. 5. CURRICULUM PROCESSES AND STUDY OF THE PROCESS: Crystle Martin/Moses Wolfenstein

C. Martin and M. Wolfenstein shared a slide presentation summarizing their first-time experience with the curriculum process and Curriculog. They concluded with a slide on suggestions and feedback for improvements. A lengthy discussion ensued regarding possible modifications to the curriculum process and Curriculog. A major issue in Curriculog occurs when comments are entered with suggested changes and the originator never sees them. It is recommended that approvers reject a proposal if any important comments are being made so that any concerns can be addressed. L. Suekawa spoke on the advantages of articulating a new course and the benefit of transfer credit for students. She clarified that articulated courses can be submitted for transfer approval and included in the upcoming catalog according to the approval cycle, as opposed to GE courses which take longer. L. Suekawa offered to give articulation trainings in the future.

6. CURRICULUM SPECIALIST'S REPORT: Curriculum Specialist – L. Marquez

L. Marquez advised members that she will be asking for feedback regarding the CCC Handbook and Curriculog. A spreadsheet will be created in Teams for collection of feedback and will be due by early May. Confirmation was received from the Chancellor's Office that new LARC minutes are not required for modified CTE programs, original minutes are sufficient. Advisory committee minutes are a local decision made by the CCC and will be discussed as a future agenda item.
