L. Suekawa reported that all current AA-Ts and AS-Ts were updated to include the Cal-GETC language, as well as adjusting some of the units. Decisions on some of the courses submitted for GE are expected in April. Chair Pro Tem Kline extended his appreciation to L. Suekawa and L. Marquez for their hard work in updating the ADTs.

5. LOCAL AA/AS DEGREE UPDATE

L. Suekawa reported that Academic Senate had first read on the Associate Degree New Title 5 Changes. A second read will take place at the next Senate meeting on March 18. Once approved by Senate, the proposal will go the Board of Trustees for final approval.

6. CURRICULUM SPECIALIST'S REPORT: Curriculum Specialist – L. Marquez

L. Marquez reported that updates to ADTs to align with Cal-GETC do not need resubmitting. Any additional updates to ADTs, including course number changes, must be manually submitted and approved by the Chancellor's Office before making any catalog changes. Outstanding changes to the catalog will be reflected in the addendum, published in summer/fall.

7. VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Vice President of Academic Affairs – C. Lopez

C. Lopez reaffirmed that Phase II of CCN will be split into two groups. Group 1 must be student facing by fall 2026; Group 2, student facing by fall 2027. C. Lopez reviewed the list of courses for each group. A list of Phase II and Phase III courses are available to view in TEAMS. Group 1 templates are expected to be received in March; Group 2 templates in April/May. Faculty convenings will take place in June to address Phase III CCN templates. The Academic Senate president may nominate up to two faculty members per discipline to attend. If interested, contact Charlene Brewer-Smith. Public forums are being planned for late March to share information on the upcoming reorganizations in Academic Affairs and Student Services.
