#### 4. Cal-GETC UPDATE

L. Suekawa reviewed a list of the 22 Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) at ECC and what updates, per AB 928 (Cal-GETC), are needed. Colleges will need to update the narrative for each ADT in the course catalog with the Cal-GETC wording by Fall 2025. In order to comply, L. Marquez will proceed with changing the ADTs to incorporate the Cal-GETC wording, including degrees pending from spring. The group of ADTs can then be processed as a batch for one approval action by the CCC. L. Suekawa will contact the divisions for those ADTs requiring additional changes, which can be updated and approved by the CCC at a later time.

# 5. CURRICULUM SPECIALIST'S REPORT: Curriculum Specialist – L. Marquez

L. Marquez provided feedback from the Fall Curriculum Regional meeting and emphasized that the college should meet the CCN deadlines in order to avoid further legislation and restrictions. Communications to students regarding Cal-GETC should be clear and suggested using graphics in the catalog, schedule, online, and around campus. L. Marquez informed the CCC that a Cal-GETC field was added to Curriculog, as well as an additional Primary Methods of Evaluation textbox. A preview of the new fields was shared onscreen.

# **6. VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** C. Martin (designee)

C. Martin attended the Chief Instructional Officers Conference with VP Lopez last week. She reported that the Chancellor's Office stressed the importance of meeting the CCN deadlines.
