Typical Assignment Using Primary Method of Evaluation:	From the list of campus supports provided in class, choose five that are most relevant to your current academic goals. Use the college website to research each selected support resource. Summarize what you have learned in a two-page paper. Include an overview of the services provided, the location where the services are offered, any requirements to access the services, key deadlines, and contact information. Discuss how you can access these resources over the next semester. Be specific about the steps you would take and any necessary preparations.
Critical Thinking Assignment 1:	Use one of the self-management tools introduced in class to plan and organize your academic, personal, and extracurricular commitments for the upcoming week. Incorporate all your responsibilities, including deadlines, study sessions, meetings, and personal time. After applying the tool, discuss your experience with a classmate, focusing on the strengths of the tool in helping you organize and manage your time and any challenges you encountered when using the tool. After your discussion, write a paragraph evaluating the effectiveness of the self-managment tool. Explain any changes you plan to make and whether you believe the tool will be useful for you.

Critical Thinking Assignment 2:	Develop a comprehensive plan that includes both short-term and long-term goals for your education and career. Assess these goals to determine whether they meet the criteria for effective goal-setting outlined in your reading. Based on your evaluation, revise your goals as needed.
