

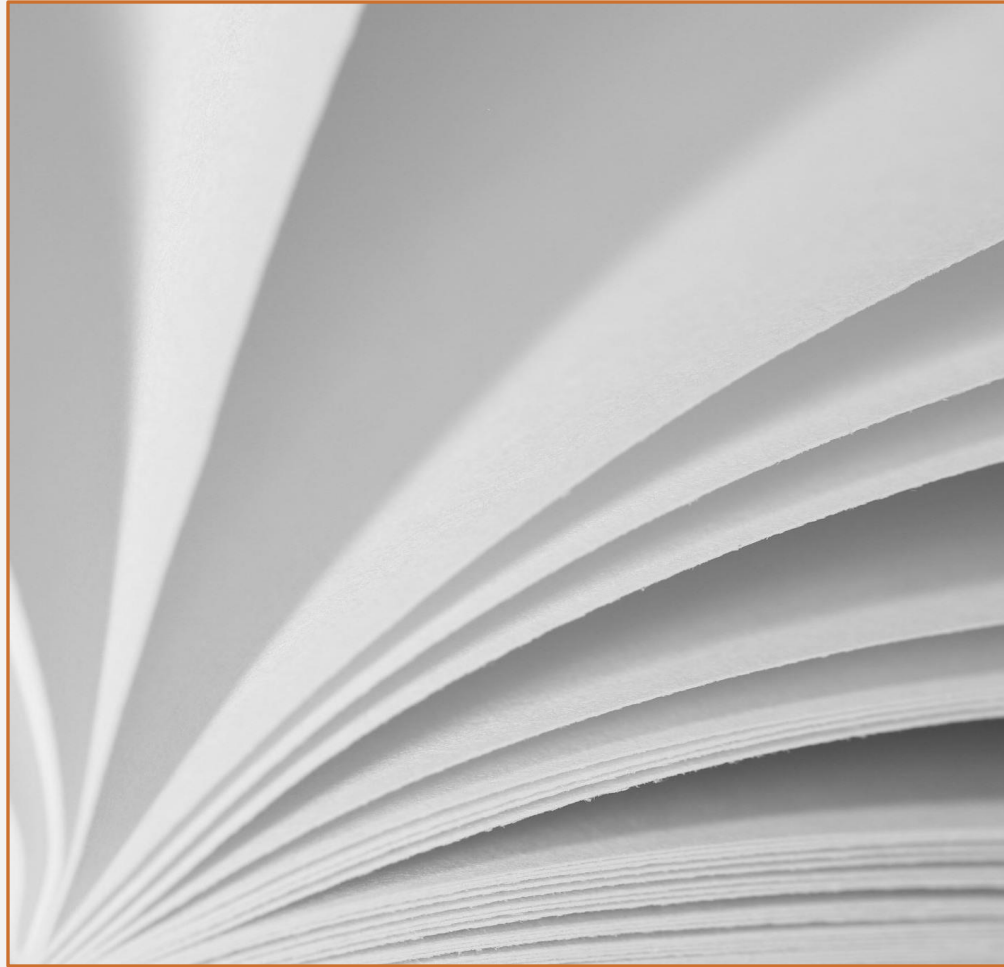


Academic Senate Meeting

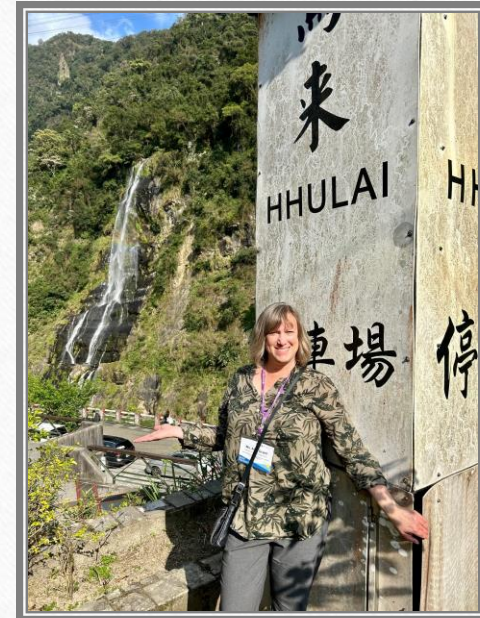

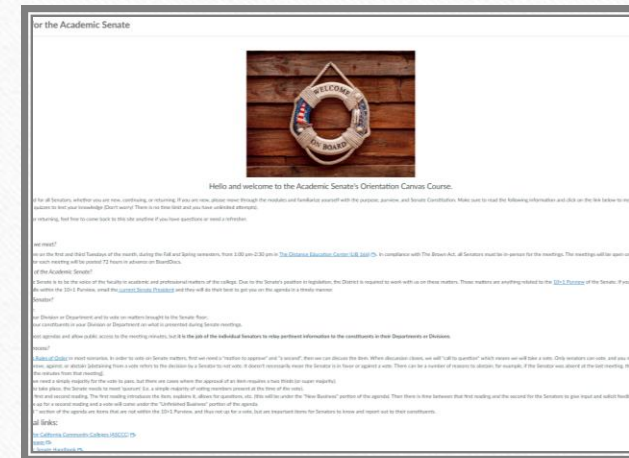
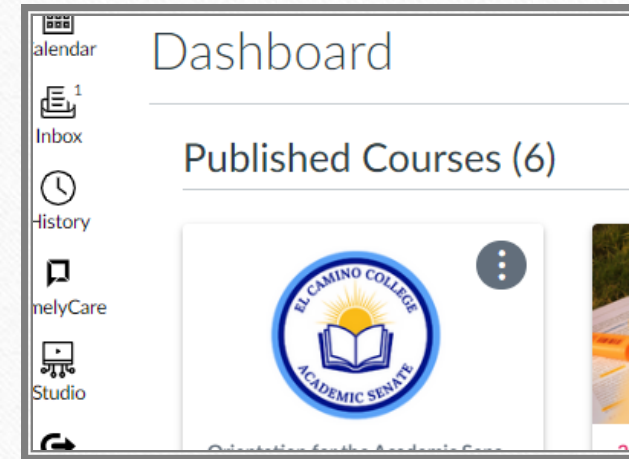
