# EOPS LEGACY

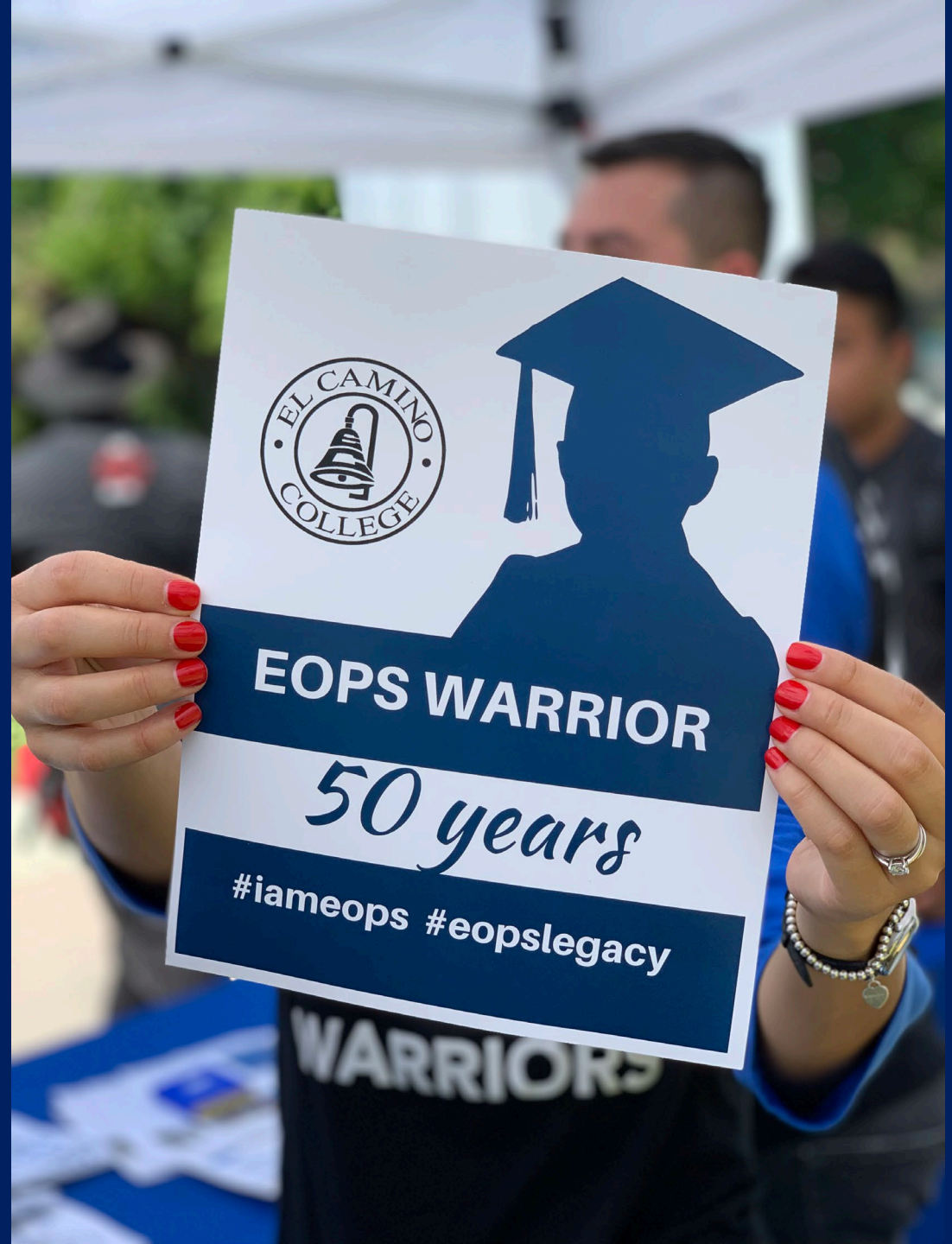
*Above and Beyond Services 1969-2019*

Extended Opportunity Programs & Services (EOPS) at El Camino College is dedicated to the delivery of a comprehensive program that encourages the enrollment, retention, and transfer of students who are challenged by language, social, economic, and educational disadvantages.

## Historical Context

EOPS was born out of the Civil Rights Movement and the social unrest experienced during the 1960s.

- .....
- 1954** *Brown V. Board of Education- Supreme Court ruled that "separate, but equal" was unconstitutional.*
- 1955** *Rosa Parks arrested- for refusing to give up her seat on a Montgomery city bus.*
- 1957** *"Little Rock Nine"- Federal troops were deployed to Little Rock Central H.S. to safely escort black students.*
- 1963** *"The Birmingham Campaign"- Peaceful and non-violent protests against segregation laws in the city were met with violent attacks and arrest by Birmingham police.*  
*March on Washington- 250,000 take part in the March for Jobs and Freedom. Martin Luther King gives the iconic "I have a Dream" speech in front of the Lincoln Memorial.*
- 1964** *Civil Rights Act of 1964- signed into law by President Lyndon Johnson. It outlawed discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.*
- 1965** *Selma to Montgomery March- Around 600 civil rights marchers walked from Selma, Alabama to Montgomery—the state's capital—to protest black voter suppression.*
- .....
- 1969** *EOPS established-Senate Bill 164 was passed, which authorized California Community Colleges to develop the EOPS program for the purpose of supporting economically and educationally disadvantaged students.*
- .....
- 1982** *CARE established- as a supplemental program of EOPS, becoming the first statewide program for single head of household student parents.*

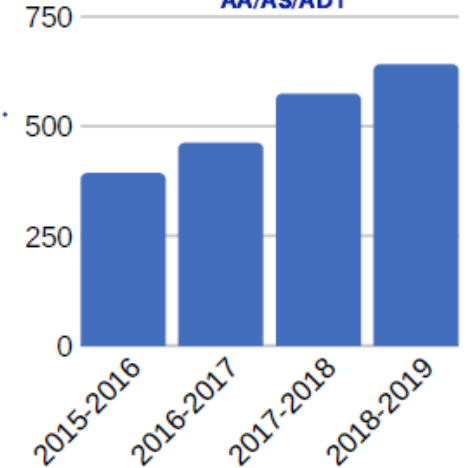

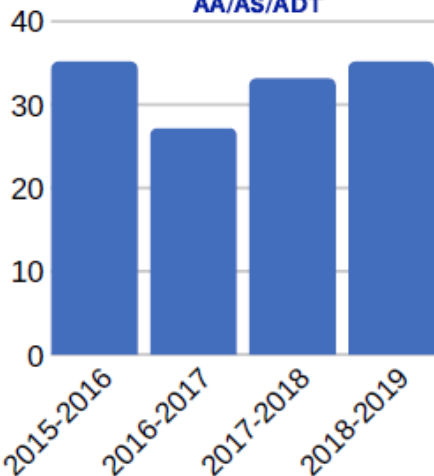

# Library Services Platform (LSP) change:


## Winter 2020

In Fall 2018, the Library and Learning Resource Center signed on with a **state-wide adoption of a new Library Services Platform (LSP), Ex Libris' Alma/Primo.**

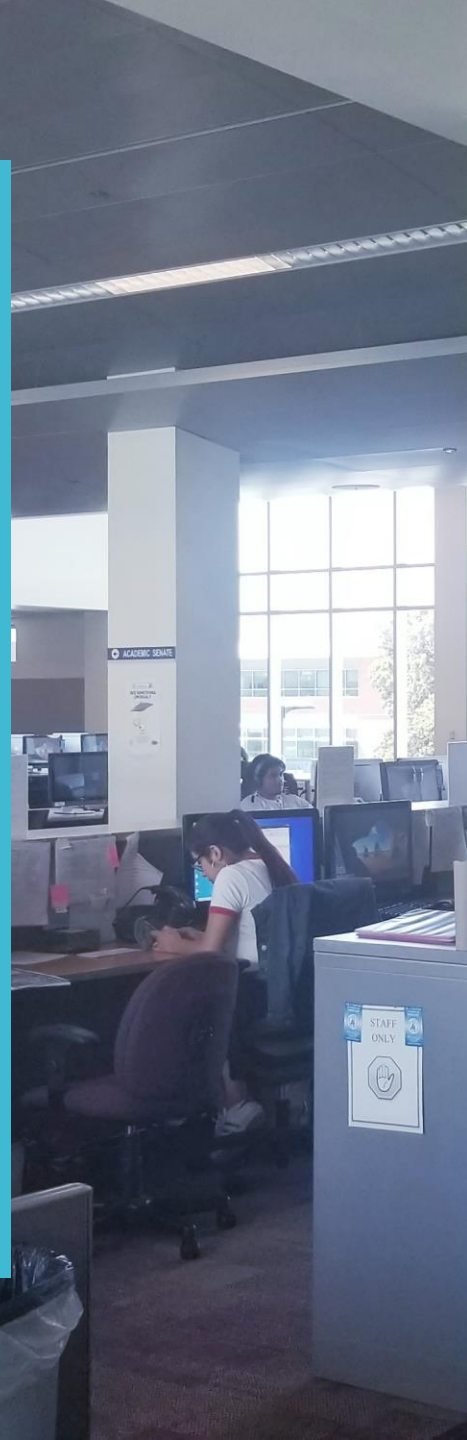

- New browsing policy allows students to enter the closed stack area and browse titles. Many unique and historical items are being discovered this way!

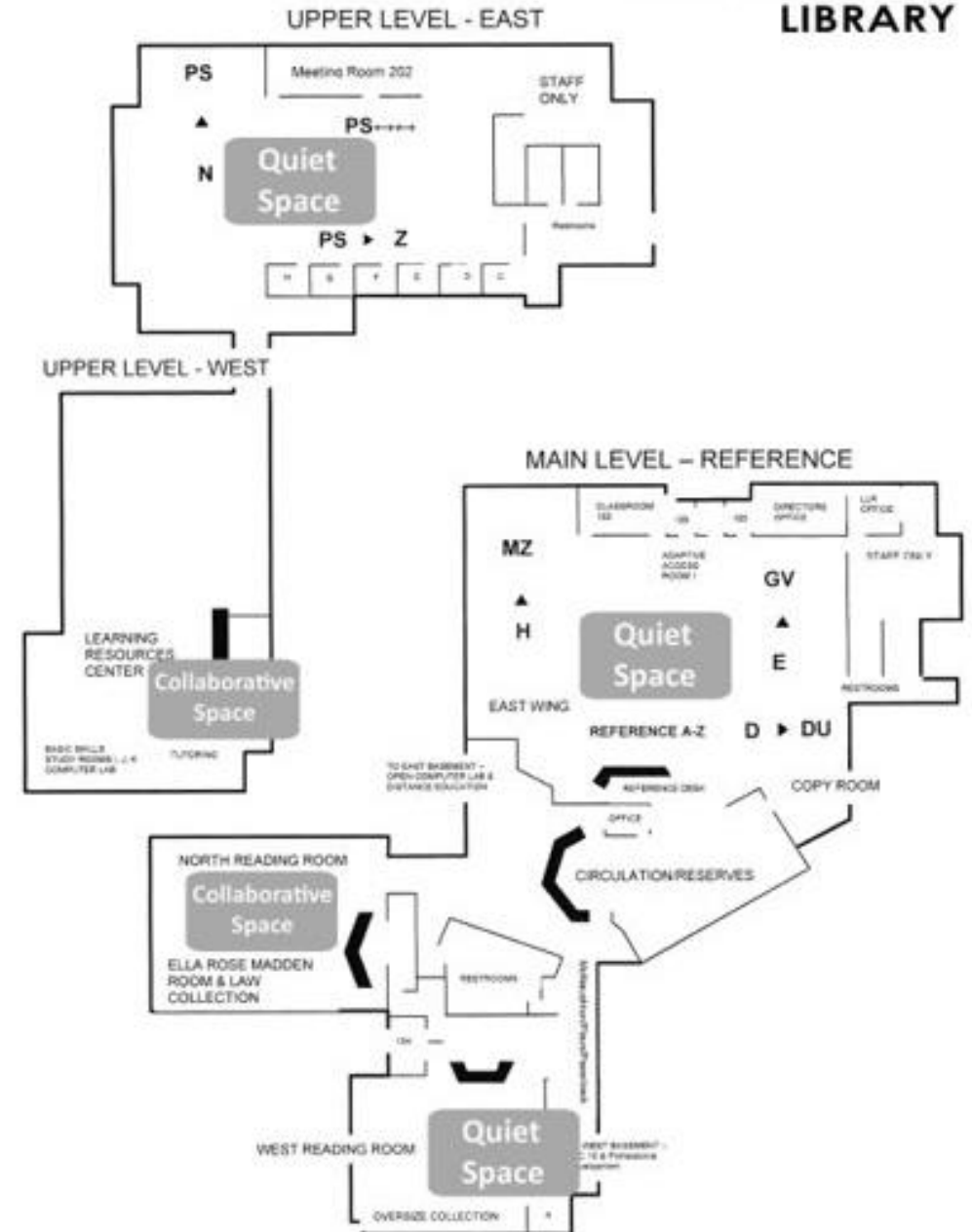


# New quiet and collaborative designated spaces

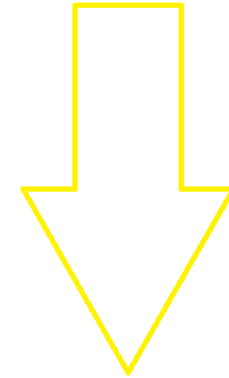

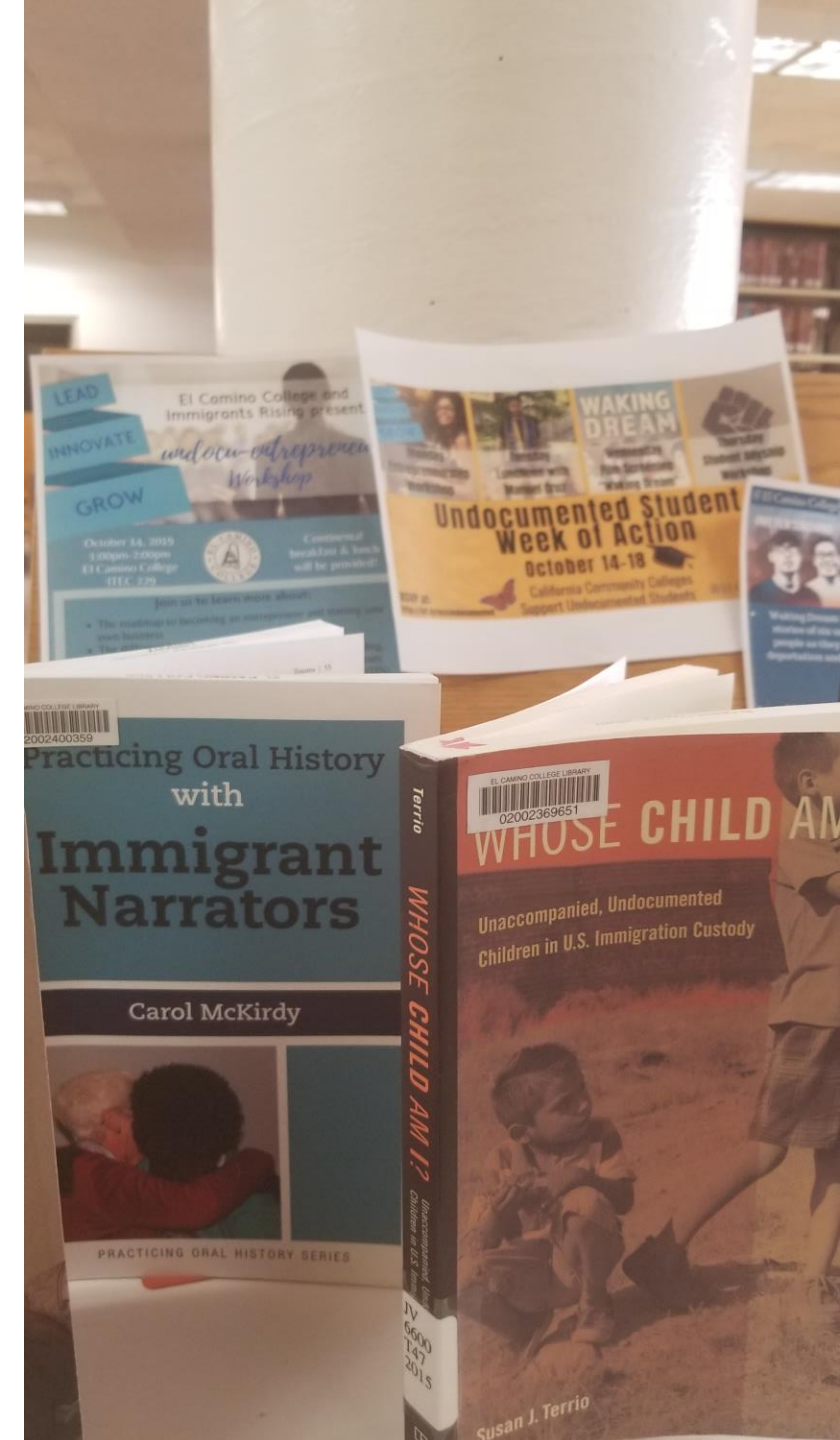
**+ 12 Part-Time Librarians!**
