# **Agenda: Equivalency Policy and Forms**

- The EPC reviewed and discussed the recommendations from the FSA/Minimum Qualification/Equivalency Task Force.
- EPC approves the task force recommendation to raise the equivalency for a master's degree from any master's with a minimum of 12 semester graduate units in the discipline, to 18 semester graduate units in the discipline. The same change was made for the BA with 30 graduate units; it is recommended the candidate also have 18 semester graduate units in the discipline.
- The EPC agreed that we should note that all non-US/foreign degrees need to be evaluated.
- The EPC clarified the new language that explains how continuing education and graduate extension course work may apply to equivalency.
- The EPC recommends that the equivalency application form should have more detail regarding the evidence required from equivalency applicants.
- Language in the old policy was updated to reflect the use of "human resources," not "personnel."
- We will continue with this discussion of equivalencies and review the revised minimum qualifications list next time.
