In what ways is the Library and Learning Resources division connecting with students to support them in a remote environment?

Library & Learning Resources offers a variety of services to students remotely. We have virtual reference help available so students can chat directly with a Library Faculty. Students can virtually request books, computers, hotspots, and calculators, and pick them up from the building. We offer virtual tutoring in a range of subjects and we have Canvas Assist available to help students with Canvas and technology questions. We do outreach to students directly through social media and email. We also share information with Faculty to make them aware of what support the library can offer. Library and Learning Resources also has a strong web presence and a strong presence in Canvas on the Tutoring Hub and the Student Services Hub. Library Faculty have also created Canvas modules to support library instruction within online classes.

AB 705 ESL Adoption Plan

- AB 705 ESL adoption plans originally due July 1, 2020 were extended to July 1, 2021
- Reminder: ESL students with a goal of degree or transfer should enter and complete a transfer-level English composition course (or an ESL course equivalent) within three years of declaring a transfer- or degree-seeking goal
- Adoption plans explain the placement method, the evidence to be collected, and why the college/district believes it will be effective
- Our plan primarily describes existing ESL placement processes, which are consistent with AB705, but with revisions and improvements scheduled for 2021

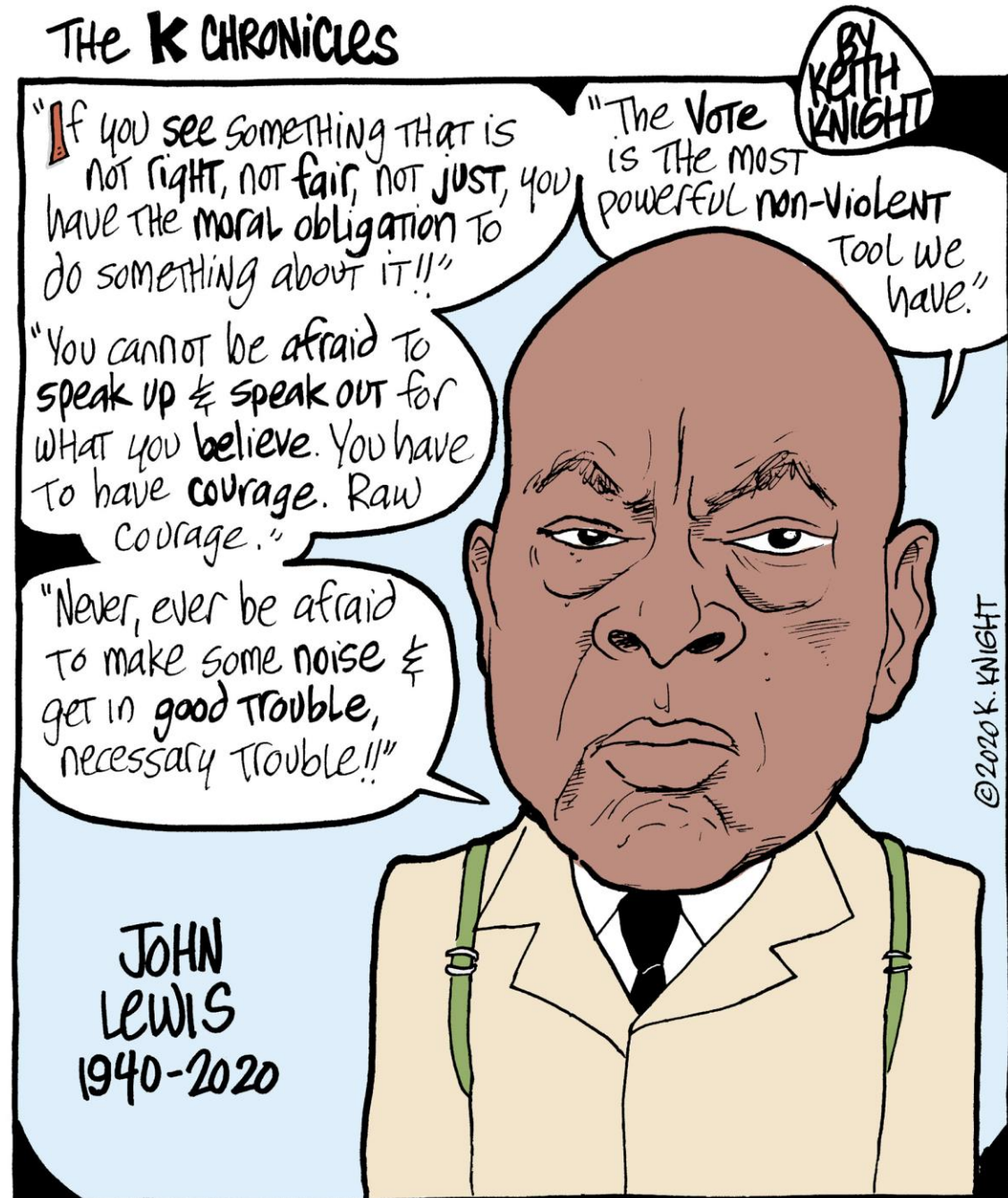
