In what ways is the Mathematical Sciences division connecting with students to support them in a remote environment?

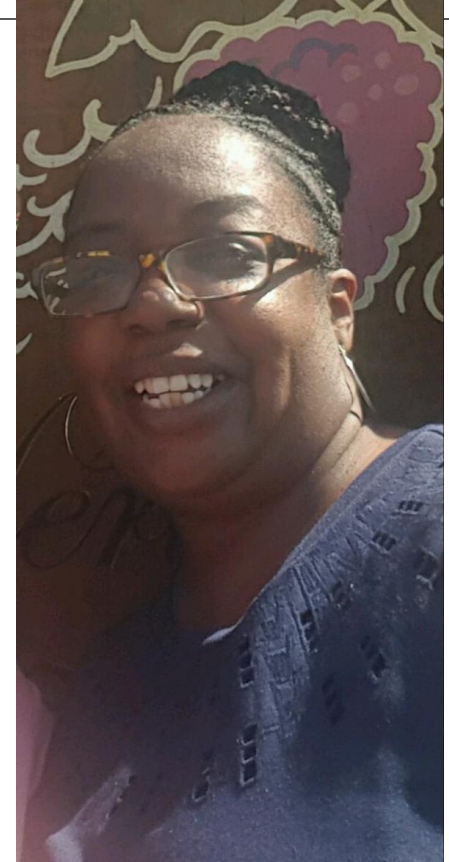
- Faculty are establishing a strong communication link with their students.
