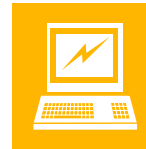

*The demand for health services such as Medical Billers is expected to continue to increase as the population ages.*

#### What does a medical biller and coder do?

Usually one person manages both medical billing and coding, but the tasks are sometimes split between two professionals. Medical coders review doctor's notes, patient records, lab results, and other clinical documentation. Medical coders assign standard medical codes to each service or diagnosis. These professionals then pass the codes to the medical biller who uses the codes to create claims.

#### Where do medical billers work?

Hospitals, physician's offices, health insurance companies, law firms and public or governmental agencies. Some medical billers and coders work remotely, either as independent contractors or with a company. Most work full time.

#### Employment outlook:

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) projects a steady 7% growth for medical billing and coding jobs between 2021 and 2031. This growth rate is about as fast as average. The BLS expects an average of 14,900 annual job openings for medical billers and coders over the decade. Median medical billing and coding salary is \$46,660 per year; usually higher in CA.

In this comprehensive 132-hour job training program, you will gain the tools and knowledge necessary to become a medical billing professional. This series provides students with basic knowledge of the national diagnostic and procedural coding systems as well as introduces the process of filing claim forms. During the coming decades, demand for highly-skilled medical biller professionals will continue to exceed the supply. Complete all six learning modules to earn a certificate of completion from El Camino College Community Education—modules may be taken out of sequence. The course also prepares you to take the National HealthCareer Association (NHA) Certified Billing Coding Specialist (CBCS) exam and includes the NHA exam preparation materials, the CBCS exam itself, and the proctoring service fee. The Medical Terminology and Medical Insurance Handbook textbooks are included with the course and will be provided in PDF formats. Students are required to purchase the coding books. Students may further seek advanced professional coding certification with other national medical coding exam organizations such as the American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC) or the Certified Professional Coder (CPC) exam. Practical coding experience of six months to two years is recommended prior to taking one of the advanced coding certification exams.

Students must pay an additional \$125 to sit for the the national exam and must pass the exam and submit all paperwork before being placed for externship. Expected externship completion/program completion is one month after the final class meeting. Students must be at least 18 years old and have their HS Diploma or equivalent prior to enrolling.

### Schedule

Class meets online on a weekday evening. Each student will also participate in a weekly 30 minute, one-on-one session with a mentor. Students start each academic week on Sunday and are required to watch all videos and start working on assignments/projects before their online class meeting. Course consists of 13-18 hours of weekly homework and content, including career service assignments utilizing LinkedIn.

### Prerequisites

Students must be 18 or over and have a high school diploma or equivalent. Basic computer literacy and the ability to navigate one's own computer is strongly preferred. Students will complete an aptitude test prior to the first class session.

Students must have access to a computer with a minimum of 8GB RAM and i5 processor. Class utilizes both Zoom and Slack for meetings and communication. Although not required, students may find a second monitor extremely helpful.

### 18-Week Online Coding Boot Camps

#### Back End Software Developer Boot Camp #210190

Back End Software Developers are in charge of building applications that do the behind-the-scenes work. This typically involves receiving requests from a Front End application, processing the request, reading and writing to a database, and responding back to requests from other applications.

In this 18-week, Back End Software Development program, students take three courses to learn the skills and technologies necessary to enter the industry as a Back End Software Developer: Introduction to Java, Relational Databases with MySQL, and Web API Design with Spring Boot. Skills and technologies learned include Java 1.8, Algorithms, OOP, Design Patterns, Unit Testing, SQL, DDL, DML, Database Concepts, JDBC, Spring Boot, Spring Data, REST, JPA, JWT, AWS, and more.

Next, there will be an exploration of the Swiss tradition at Teuscher Chocolates, a global brand that ensures consistency by regular air delivery from Europe. Here also you will be amazed at the décor and the

hand-crafted gift boxes. Taking time out for lunch on your own at the comfortable La Scala Restaurant (and an espresso or a glass of red wine if you are so inclined), engage in conversation with your excursion companions to discover what has brought them to this unique journey. After lunch, the exploration will continue at Letterpress Chocolate, a bean-to-bar factory, where you will discover and taste the intricacies of fine cacao from around the globe's chocolate belt. These chocolatiers who process their own cacao beans will take you into their factory and show you how every step of the chocolate-making process is done on site. *Itinerary subject to change.* The factory tour requires attendees to wear closed-toe shoes and to not wear perfume, cologne, or heavy-scented lotions/oils. *Excursion fee includes factory tours and tasting fees.*
