

ART HISTORY MAJOR – TRANSFER REOUIREMENTS

Art history is the study of art created in the past by individuals from various cultures and parts of the world. The art historian seeks to interpret and understand many types of works of art, ranging from the minor to the monumental, by learning about artists' lives and their societies. Art historians pursue a wide variety of careers, including but not limited to art advisor, art lawyer, art preservationist, art administrator, corporate curator, teacher or professor, art gallery worker, art librarian, estate appraiser, antiques dealer, freelance collection manager or writer – to name but a few.

ART HISTORY AA-T REQUIREMENTS

Students who have completed the AA-T in Art History will have a strong academic foundation in the field and will be prepared for upper division baccalaureate study at the university. This coursework will satisfy most of the lower-division requirements at many institutions within the California State University system. This degree is intended for students who major in art history and may provide priority consideration for admission to a CSU.
