CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Political Science programs are designed to provide students with an understanding of politics, its processes, its theories, and its institutions. Political science programs are an excellent background for leadership in civic and political activities. Political science majors take education courses in order to be certified as teachers; others seek employment with government or private agencies. Political science is considered good preparation for law school, civil service careers at international, national and local levels of government, or careers in research. This major may also lead to many other careers. For additional possibilities, check the EUREKA computerized career database, the Occupational Outlook Handbook, or one of the many other career resources located in the Career and Transfer Center.

POLITICAL SCIENCE AA-T REQUIREMENTS

Students who have completed the AA-T in Political Science will have a strong academic foundation in the field and will be prepared for upper division baccalaureate study at the university. This coursework will satisfy most of the lower-division requirements at many institutions within the California State University system. This degree is intended for students who major in political science and may provide priority consideration for admission to a CSU.

Students considering transferring to a UC, private, or out of state university: Please consult with a counselor before applying to transfer since transfer requirements may be slightly different than those required for the AA-T.

*Note: while not required for admission, all Social Sciences majors must satisfy a mathematics requirement. Courses at ECC that may be used to satisfy this requirement are Math 190 and Math 150 or Psychology 109A or Sociology 109A.
