Review Minutes

G. Fry motions to approve the minutes, A. Hernandez seconds, all in favor to approve the minutes from February 22, 2024.

Course Review

- a. Math Courses
 - Inactivation: Math 12, 23, 17A, 27A, 47A. – Currently at the CCC level.
 - Greg launched Math 190 and 191 and it is currently at the department Level; another reminder was sent to the math faculty and soon should be at the DCC level.
- b. CS course review
 - Cross listing CSCI-8 & CSCI-9 – Current and final update: CSCI 8 and CSCI 9 will not be cross listing, just adding math as a discipline to allow math faculty to teach these two courses without going through the equivalency process.
 - CS 1,12, 14, 40, 99 (two-year) – Courses CS 8, 9 and 99 are at the department level. The remaining courses are being reviewed and should be at the department level soon.

Dean's Remarks

- c. List of courses requiring Math 170 and/or Math 180 – The following courses that will require Math 170 are the following:
 - CSCI 1
 - CSCI 14
 - Math 180
 - PHYS 2A
 - CSCI 1H

It was explained that Math 170 could be waived for the above courses with AB 705 requirements. Math 180 and PHYS 2A are the only courses that require completion of Math 170.

The following courses that will require Math 180 are the following:

- Math 165

- Math 190

d. Updates on non-credit courses

- Math Academy Non-Credit – Dr. Lemons mentioned that there will be two sets of non-credit math courses that will be coming from the math division office, but the current winter and summer academies that include scientific math, Algebra, Intermediate algebra, Trigonometry, Pre-calculus and Calculus will still be offered.
 1. First set of non-credit math courses will help earn a non-credit certificate, such as a basic math certificate.
 2. Second set will be stem based non-credit courses and this will help towards a stem non-credit certificate.
