Canvas Outcomes Fall 2023

PLO Assessment

- Completion rate for at 100% for our division.

- Vice president would like for PLO assessments officially in program review, this should not affect our division as we already do so.

• At the moment, PLO's are assessed every year with the corresponding SLO's, one upcoming change, there will be an option, all the PLO's can be completed at once every 4 years right before program review. C. Schult-Roman recommended discussing these options with your designated committees.

ILO Assessment: Ensure Learning

- It was mentioned that potentially an email will be sent asking to show evidence of learning in our different programs. Some out of the box ideas included festivals and contests, this will be shared in the ILO assessment reports. It was mentioned that this will be voluntary, but it is highly encouraged as President Thames and Vice President Carlos are concerned about the ILO. They would like this ILO to be ready to be presented by Spring 2024 at the first Academic Senate meeting.
- The two courses that have been identified that are relevant to this ILO and Guided Pathways are Math 150 and Math 170. Essentially, what we're going to be doing with those courses is we're going to be looking at the SLO data from the past 4 years and we're going to compile that data, then do a quick analysis and write a report. It should take an hour to do each one of the classes. President Thames and the Vice President have placed an importance and urgency on this ILO and have assigned 20 hours of special assignment time during the course of winter break. Please email C. Schult-Roman if you are interested by Thursday because it needs to be board approved.
