Dual Enrollment

Do I need to apply for admission again?

Beginning Fall 2019, high school students no longer need to apply online for every term they wish to enroll in El Camino College courses.

High School students need to apply for admission **the first term** they enroll in El Camino College courses. This application will remain in good standing as long as you continue to enroll.

High school students who **do not enroll** in El Camino College courses **for consecutive Fall and Spring terms** will have to **apply for admission again** using their existing OpenCCC account.


NOTE: High School students still need to submit a completed paper <u>Dual Enrollment</u> <u>Application</u> for every term they wish to enroll.

How can I check?

Students can check in <u>MyECC</u> to determine if they need to apply again.

Sign in with your MyECC email and password, then in the Self-Service Menu click "Registration." Click on "My Class Schedule" and select a term to **confirm your enrollment** in the most recent Fall or Spring semester.

NOTE: Your **Registration Appointment** will not appear in MyECC until after you have submitted your Dual Enrollment Application for a term.



Applying again

To apply again, go to www.elcamino.edu/apply and click the button to Begin Application for El Camino College. Then click the Sign In button to sign into your existing **OpenCCC account**.



Apply for admission as a college student after high school

When preparing to enroll for your first term after high school graduation, submit another application for admission with your updated enrollment status: **First-time student in college** (after leaving high school).



See above for steps to apply again with your existing OpenCCC account.

Once submitted, this application will also remain in good standing as long as you do not miss consecutive Fall and Spring terms.
