Why Dual Enrollment?

- A. **Get ahead** Earn high school and college credit at the same time, one semester usually equals one year
- B. Save time Earn a college degree faster by starting early
- C. Save money Enrollment fees are waived!
- D. Build confidence Experience and succeed in college-level courses, become familiar with college admission and registration processes
- E. Stand out on university/college applications
- F. Follow a passion or interest
- G. Explore careers and majors

Two Types of Dual Enrollment

Dual Enrollment in El Camino College Classes

- Traditional college classes (on-campus and online)
- Open to public, students **register themselves** to save their seat
- K-12 students complete all Steps for Dual Enrollment and purchase required textbooks/materials

Dual Enrollment in High School Partnership Classes

- A.k.a. Dual Enrollment, Career Pathways, or Early College classes
- Not open to public, just for students at local high school/district
- K-12 students complete Steps 1-2 only, are **manually registered** by ECC staff, high school provides textbooks/materials

Two Types of Dual Enrollment

For both types

- Enrollment fees (and other misc. fees) are waived!
- Classes count for college credit (on college transcript) and high school credit (as determined by high school)
- Same steps (but Steps 3-4 done for students in HS Partnership Classes)

16-Week Semester


- Tuesday, February 18, to Monday, June 16, 2025

 - Second 8-Week Session ("Mid-Term Classes") starts April 21



- Submit a new completed form for <u>each term</u> (Winter 2025, Spring 2025, etc.)
- Form must include:
 - Term and Year (example: Spring 2025)
 - <u>Drawn</u> Student Signature
 - <u>Drawn</u> Parent Signature
 - <u>Drawn</u> Authorized Signature from principal or counselor
 - Your Grade Level and High School Graduation year
 - Dean's signature also required for students in Grades K-10 (see Course Restrictions & Division Dean Approval)

- Also Course #1 and Course #2 you would like to register for
 - Example: History 102 and Mathematics 150
 - Grants course permission to be eligible to register for <u>any class</u> <u>section</u> of History 102 and Mathematics 150 offered that term
- Dual Enrollment is limited to:
 - 11 units during the Fall and Spring Semesters
 - 2 courses during the Summer Term (maximum of 8 units)
 - 1 course during the Winter Session
 - Refer to <u>Catalog</u> or <u>Class Schedule</u> to determine unit counts


Step 3. Clear Any Prerequisites


- Students need to complete this step before they can register themselves for a course with a Prerequisite, including:
 - All Mathematics courses
 - Computer Science courses
 - Most English courses Typically 12th grade only
 - Chemistry & Physics courses
 - Language courses higher than 1
- Different methods to clear (complete Placement Survey, meet with Express Counselor, submit online form). See Step 3 of the Steps for Dual Enrollment

Step 4. Register for Classes


- Search for Classes and Register for Classes using MyECC
- Register anytime on or after your Registration Appointment (earliest date/time you can register)
 - Registration starts November 25 and December 2 for priority college students
 - K-12 students will receive Winter Registration Appointments for afternoon of Wednesday, November 27
 - K-12 students will receive Spring Registration Appointments for afternoon of Thursday, December 5

- Registration Appointment is simply the earliest date/time you can register for classes
 - Populated in MyECC as we get near the start of registration (sometimes after your form is processed)
 - No Registration Appointment necessary after first week of registration (Open Registration)

Waitlist Classes

- After a class section reaches capacity...
 - Can no longer register
 - Instead join waitlist (usually 10 students)
- If seats become available **before Start Date**, then waitlisted students are moved to roster automatically (in waitlist order)
- On/After Start Date, only way to register is with Authorization to Add provided by the instructor
- K-12 students must have a Dual Enrollment Form on file for the term and have cleared any prerequisites





- Canvas account created <u>only after</u> you register for first online class
 - Usually created within 24 hours (overnight)
- Sign in using El Camino's Canvas Login Page link only
 - Important for high schools which use Canvas! El Camino classes will only appear if you sign in using link on El Camino webpage
- Canvas Login Page will direct you to sign in using same
 MyECC Username and Password
- Make sure you can sign into Canvas prior to start of class


During the Class

- Keep up with attendance, assignments, discussion, quizzes, etc. as outlined in Syllabus
- Need to miss a class? Make sure instructor knows
- Need to Drop?
 - Students need to perform this action themselves in MyECC by drop deadline dates
 - After Last Day to Drop with a "W" instructors must submit a grade for every student on roster

Drop a Class

Drop Classes

- Click Add/Drop a Class (same screen as Register Here)
- Find a class section you wish to drop and click **Drop** button
- This action cannot be undone in MyECC
 - Students looking to be reinstated need to email their instructor
 - Only with instructor consent will Admissions & Records add student back to roster




End of Class

- Final grades submitted by instructor within 7 days after last date of class
- Final grades visible in both MyECC and Canvas

- Academic Profile card
 - Grades
 - Unofficial Student Transcript
 - Unofficial Transcript contents same as Official Transcript
 - Sometimes enough to show high school to receive any high school credit. All high school credit given at determination of high school.

- Order online at <u>Transcripts Webpage</u>
- Uses Parchment vendor to send secure transcripts directly to desired institution(s)
 - Can send to your high school or universities/colleges
 - If your high school requires Official Transcripts, please confirm with them electronic vs. hard copy and the email or physical address where transcripts need to be sent
 - First two transcript copies are free, \$6 per transcript after that


