
### **Evolve: Year in Review**

This rebrand is to support the new direction of refocusing on service to students and fellow colleagues, as well as to simplify the submission process for individuals who may not know who an employee's manager is.


The committee is working on finalizing designs and a launch date, but wanted to share that you will be able to keep acknowledging your colleagues on the good work we do on campus.
