CCC Report – B. Carey

TMC Updates

Geology AS-T is approved by the CCC. Pre Physics AS-T is in process. There was some discussion back and forth about which courses of Physics 1B/1C/1D should be part of the degree, without requiring excessive units. Geography and Biology degrees are being voted by the state and then will come to departments.
