CAL STATE APPLY GRADE REPORTING GUIDELINES

SCENARIO # 1:

Student earns D/F grade in course taken at a community college, student repeats course at <u>same</u> community college. Self-report first attempt as "Repeat" (RP) and second attempt as C or better grade. Only second grade will be calculated into CSU GPA.

<i>Example: El Camino College <u>Fall 2021</u> Psych 101 3 units</i>	Ð/F	Report as "RP"

SCENARIO # 2:

Student earns D/F grade in course taken at a community college, student repeats equivalent course at <u>different</u> community college. Self-report <u>first</u> attempt as D/F grade and <u>second</u> attempt as C or better grade. Both grades will be calculated into CSU GPA.

D/F	Report as D/F
В	Report as B

A. File a petition at the community college where student earned D/F grade to request a notation indicating that course grade was alleviated due to repetition of equivalent course at another community college. Have the other college send "official" transcripts to ECC. Example:

Fall 2021Psych 101 3 unitsXD/XFReport as "RP"

(ECC utilizes an X notation on transcript)

B. File a petition at the community college where student earned D/F grade to request a notation indicating that the course grade was alleviated due to "Academic Renewal"

<u>Fall 2021</u> Psych 101 3 units LD/LF Report as "AR"

(ECC utilizes an "L" notation on transcript)

El Camino College Academic Renewal Policy:

A student may petition to have up to 30 semester units of substandard work (D, F or WF grade assigned) taken at El Camino College disregarded in the determination of the grade point average (GPA), subject to limitations as follows:

1. The student must have completed a minimum of 12 semester units with at least a 2.0 GPA at a regionally accredited college or university

2. At least one major semester (Fall or Spring) must have passed since the substandard grade(s) was awarded. Winter Intersessions and Summer Terms do NOT count as semesters.
