AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A TAG?

__ You must meet the definition of a California Community College (CCC) student

- You have been enrolled at one or more CCCs for at least 2 regular terms (excludes summer sessions)
- You are attending a CCC as your last college before transfer (excludes summer sessions) and in good standing

__ You must meet the following unit requirements for fall 2025 admission:

- Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) UC-transferable units
 - By end of summer 2024: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units (may include AP/IB units)
 - By end of spring 2025: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more CCC's

__ You must complete the following 7-course pattern by the end of spring 2025 for fall 2025 admission, earning a grade of "C" or better in each course:

- Two UC-transferable English Composition courses; one UC-transferable Math course; four UC-transferable courses from two of the following three areas: Arts/Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences and Physical/Biological Sciences

__ No more than 19 UC-transferable semester units can be in progress in Spring 2025 to reach the 60-unit minimum

__ Must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA with a "C" or better grade in all UC-transferable coursework during the fall 2024, winter 2025, and spring 2025 terms, with no grade lower than a "C"

__ TAGs are not available to students who previously enrolled at a UC during a regular term (excluding summer) and intend to apply to the same UC

HOW DO I APPLY FOR A UCM TAG?

__ Use the UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) at (<https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu>) to complete and submit an online UC TAG application between **September 1-30, 2024** (you can only apply for a TAG at **one** UC campus)

__ Submit a UC admission application to UCI at (<apply.universityofcalifornia.edu>) between **October 1-November 30, 2024** (for the same major as the TAG application)

LIMITATIONS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

__ No unrepeatable grade(s) of "No Pass", "C-", "D" or "F" in UC transferable courses.

__ No more than (2) total withdrawals in major preparation courses (including Excused Withdrawals).

__ Applicants may not have more than one major preparation course with a grade of "No Pass", "D" or "F" even if the course has been repeated with a passing grade.

__ If you have taken any courses at a four-year university, you may not reach or exceed 80 semester (120 quarter) units of combined CCC lower division and four-year upper division units.
