AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A TAG?

You must meet the definition of a California Community College (CCC) student

- You have been enrolled at one or more CCC's for at least 2 regular terms (excludes summer sessions)
- You are attending a CCC as your last college before transfer (excludes summer sessions) and in good standing

You must meet the following unit requirements for fall 2025 admission:

- Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) UC-transferable units
 - By the end of summer 2024: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units (may include AP/IB units)
 - By the end of spring 2025: Complete 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at one or more CCC's

You must complete the following 7-course pattern by the end of spring 2025 for fall 2025 admission, earning a grade of "C" or better in each course:

- Two UC-transferable English Composition courses; one UC-transferable Math course; four UC-transferable courses from two of the following three areas: Arts/Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences and Physical/Biological Sciences

No more than 19 UC-transferable semester units can be in progress in Spring 2025 to reach the 60-unit minimum

Must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA with a "C" or better grade in all UC-transferable coursework during the fall 2024, winter 2025, and spring 2025 terms

TAGs are not available to students who previously enrolled at a UC during a regular term (excluding summer) and intend to apply to the same UC

HOW DO I APPLY FOR A UCR TAG?

Use the UC Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) at (<https://uctap.universityofcalifornia.edu>) to complete and submit an online UC TAG application between **September 1-30, 2024** (you can only apply for a TAG at **one** UC campus)

Submit a UC admission application to UCI at (apply.universityofcalifornia.edu) between **October 1-November 30, 2024** (for the same major as the TAG application)

LIMITATIONS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If you have taken any courses at a four-year university, you may not reach or exceed 80 semester (120 quarter) units of combined CCC lower division and four-year upper division units
