The Board of Trustees of the El Camino Community College District met at 4:00 p.m. on July 15, 2019, in the Alondra Room of the El Camino College Bookstore.

The SRC will coordinate with the Complainant and the external exam provider to ensure that the Complainant has access to accommodations that the provider allows and that those accommodations are implemented.
- 3. The College will develop and implement SRC policies and/or procedures regarding the provision of accommodations for certification and other testing administered as part of a College class and/or for a class grade or credit, involving an outside entity.
