This significantly reduces our lifecycle costs for providing student accessible computers. We are looking at other options such as the Microsoft Educational Laptop that is similar to the Chromebook but runs Windows 10 applications and Office 365. It will come with Windows Defender Live for security access for anti-virus and anti-malware, which Chromebook does not have. We are trying to find a security application for those items on Chromebook. We can apply the Cisco AMP security product on all of our Apple devices.
