- Brief information from yesterday's cabinet:
 - o Jorge presented information on the capital projects that is going on campus
 - Music building will begin construction in March.
 - Behavioral Science and Art Complex construction will begin in the next four to six weeks.
 - Baseball field renovation is underway and completion by Fall.
 - Restoration of the Manhattan Café will being soon.
 - There area about twenty or so project that will be underway on campus and by next fall 2022 the center of campus is going to look a lot different.
 - Work is beginning on the budget for FY2021-22.
 - Attended the Governor's budget workshop and the State economic outlook is brighter compared to last year this time.
 - There is a \$5B surplus than last year, where there was a \$5B deficit due to COVID-19 and the subsequent recession.
 - Budget hearing at the state will start next month and we will not know anything more until the May Revise, around first or second week in May.
 - Seems COVID-19 outbreak on campus is once a week but early in the month it seems it was lot more in a week.
 - Reminder: wear a mask, socially distance, wash your hand frequently, and sanitize.
 - Make sure to ask your supervisor/manger where the PPE are kept in the office.
 - Since there is a new strain of the virus, it is recommended that everyone wear two masks.
 - ECC is now the LA County's vaccine site by appointment.
 - Marketing and Communications sent out a message about where to go for appointments if you fall under the <u>LA County vaccine criteria</u>.
