Equivalency and Evaluation Information

RECOGNIZED EQUIVALENT OF A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

The U.S. Department of Education recognizes the following as the equivalent of a high school diploma:

- A General Educational Development (GED) certificate; **or**
- A state certificate awarded after passing an authorized test and that the state recognizes as equivalent to a high school diploma (Example: California High School Proficiency Examination, HiSET, TASC, or other state-authorized examination). **or**
- An official academic transcript showing that the student has successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree; **or**
- For a student seeking enrollment in a program of at least the associate degree level, documentation showing that he/she excelled academically in high school and has met the formalized written admissions policies of the college. An official transcript indicating that the student has excelled in high school is required. The student must no longer be enrolled in high school.
