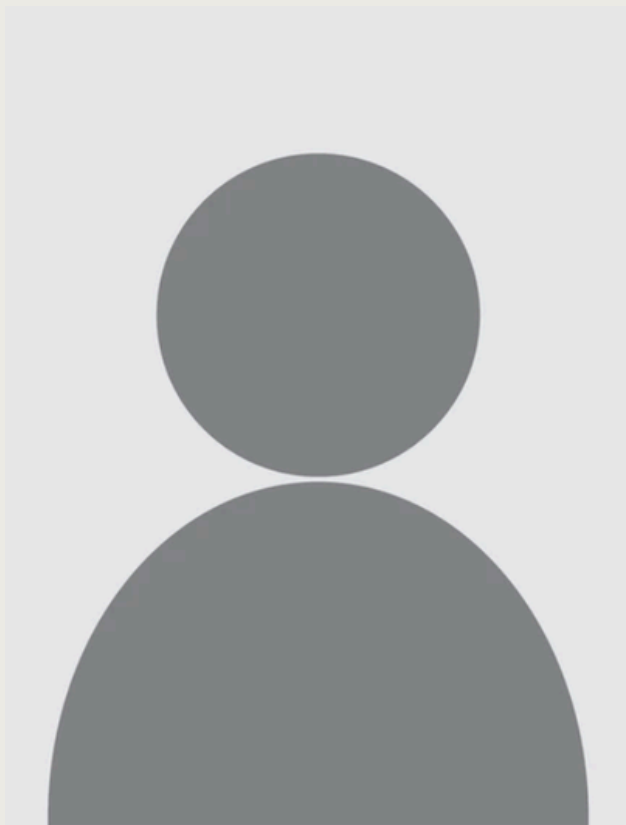

SHREYANS RANA



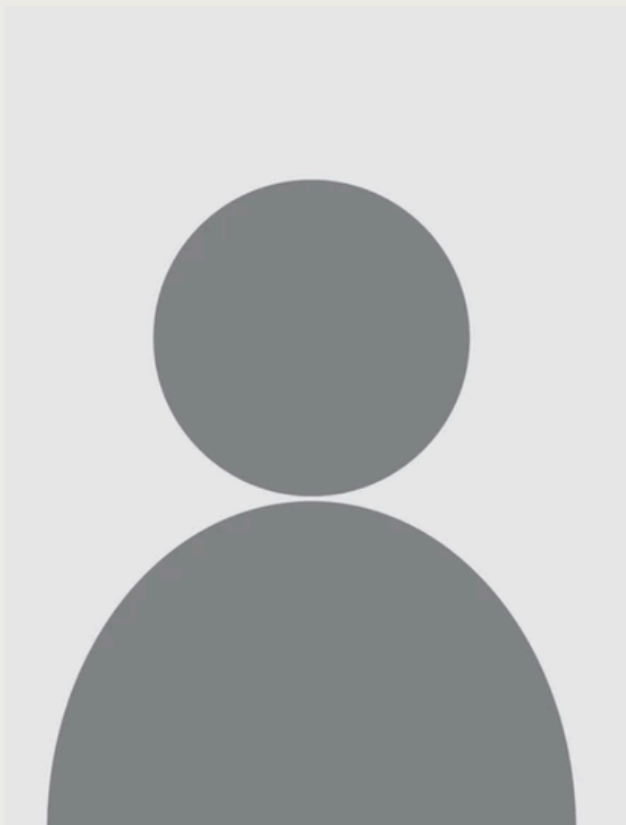

MARIA LEWIS



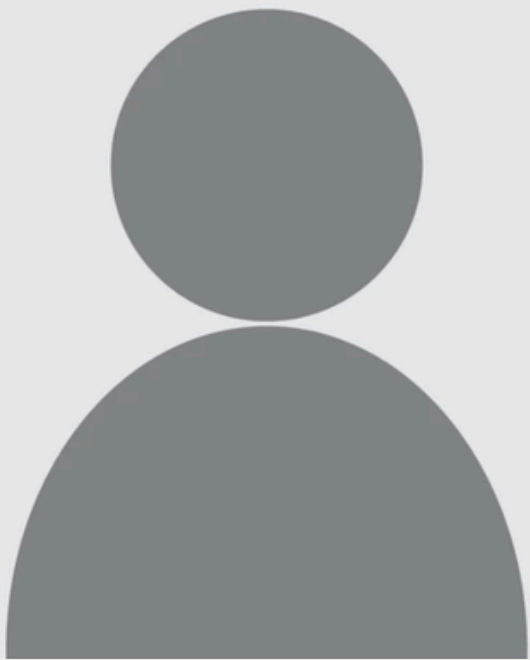

THEA NGUYEN



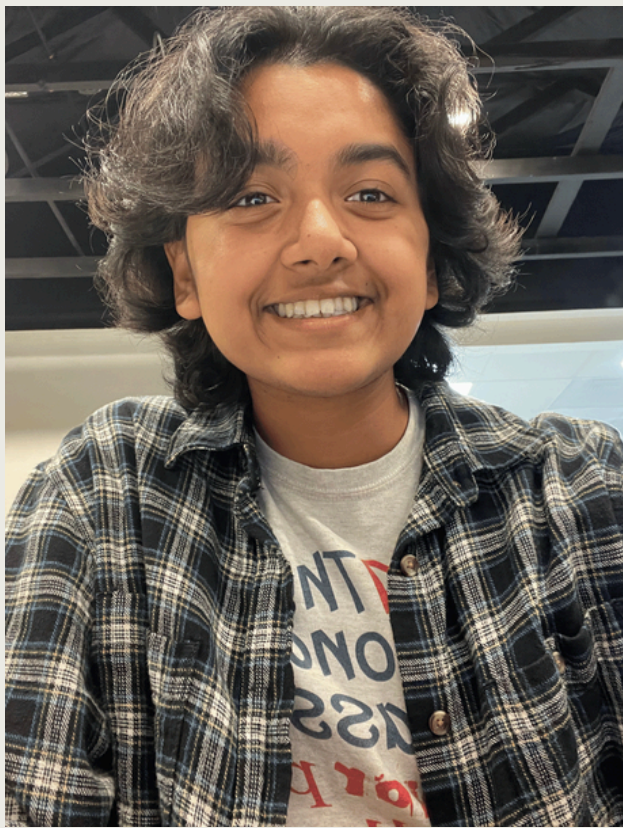
