Statement of Purpose

The Campus and Workplace Safety and Security Consultation Committee is proposed to be an administrative advisory committee that:

- promotes safety, security awareness, and emergency preparedness across campus
- advises on policy development and implementation
- advises on campus safety/security practices
- assists with emergency/incident planning and training

The primary role of the committee is be to review and evaluate the effectiveness of current safety and security plans and practices and make recommendations for improvement. The committee provides a forum to discuss events affecting campus safety and security and assist with campus-wide dissemination of information/communication relating to emergency/incident training and response plans. The committee also assists in assessment of vulnerabilities, hazards and risks related to the safety and security of individuals and the physical campus.
