Budget Strategies Leadership Taskforce Related Q&A

On the webpage, agendas are posted but not all meeting notes.

- Representatives are reminded to disseminate information to their constituent groups after the meetings.

Can budget reduction recommendations from the campus community be published online or shared publicly for transparency?

- Recommendations, from the Taskforce, will be posted on the webpage no later than two weeks after the meeting.
- An electronic suggestion box or, for more transparency, a shared Google Sheet will be created for recommendations from the campus community. The link will be sent to the campus community.
- Feedback or suggestions on reducing the budget can be provided to your constituent representative(s) on Planning and Budget Committee (PBC) or Budget Strategies Leadership Taskforce.

Can the Taskforce membership roster and email addresses be posted, prominently, on the webpage?

• Yes. The meeting schedule and membership roster with email addresses will be added to the webpage.

Can the campus community receive regular updates on the Taskforce?

- Yes. Constituent groups should be receiving information from their representatives.
- A status update will be a standing item for the monthly Budget Forums.
- Taskforce representatives will report out to College Council in addition to PBC.
  - College Council and PBC representatives should communicate the activities of the Taskforce to their constituent groups.

How was the membership of the Taskforce selected?

- The suggestion to form a Taskforce, representing a cross section of constituent representatives, to discuss budget matters, originated from an Academic Senate member who recollected, a similar taskforce was formed previously.
- Elected campus leaders were invited to the Taskforce. Once convened, it was agreed each member would invite one person, who understood budgets, to join the Taskforce.
- The Taskforce is comprised of elected leaders and decision makers versus PBC which is a recommending body.

Taskforce representatives indicated open meetings would hinder open and honest discussion.
