Updates:

Jimmy Macareno in Facilities has replaced some of the stop signs in lots H and F. Mitchell is working on a quote to purchase more stop signs that need replacement.

Parking Update - Lot L

A construction crew is digging up the asphalt in lot L by the traffic circle, making way for the modular village. In that area, about 200 parking spaces will be lost.

The Fire Tech Academy will be in lot L west (against the channel). That project will take away about 235 parking spaces.

The proposed student housing will also be in Lot L. That project will also take away more student parking spaces and will have its own parking for its residents.

There is still plenty of parking in the structures, as they are not fully utilized. The upper levels of lot C and H have not been filling up as well as the upper and lower levels of lot F, due to many students taking online classes. Between lots C, F, and H, there are about 2,200 stalls not being used.

The Roadium parking is being renegotiated and will possibly move to an alternate lot.
