## Parking Update – First week of Spring Semester

A report of the parking lot capacity for the first week of the semester was shared. Lot L Center lost parking due to construction. Construction in lot L west has not started yet and is still available for parking. Lot L is the most heavily used lot. Lots C, F and H still have stalls available. Mondays and Wednesdays are the busiest days for parking. There is still plenty of parking and there are about 2,500 stalls that are open and available for students.

Jonelle – Lot B has many handicap stalls that are not always filled. It is possible that those stalls are for van accessible parking because the vans aren't able to fit in lot C and the stalls in Lot B are painted wider.

Alondra – The A.S.O. would like to know if they can get staff parking for their cabinet (currently 8 students). They have to attend committee meetings and events and sometimes have to carry heavy materials.

Mitchell will look up the guidelines and asked the A.S.O to speak with Karin regarding the request. Have Karin email him and he will follow up with her.

Rebecca – Is it possible to keep track of how many carpool stalls are being used? As part of the AQMD guidelines, there has to be a certain number of stalls designated as carpool and they need to be spread out in different areas around campus.

Amy asked if all of Lot A is handicap as there seems to be more than before? Yes, lot A north is handicap parking. This may be due to the removal of some handicap stalls in other areas, so they were moved to lot A because of the required amount of handicap stalls needed on campus.
