Homeless Student Overnight Parking

A staff member had asked Chief Trevis if there was a safe place for one of their homeless students to park overnight. There is no current district policy for overnight parking for homeless students and it would be a lengthy process to establish one. There was an Assembly Bill written a couple of years ago that would have allowed overnight parking for homeless students however, it was not passed.

Currently, overnight parking is not allowed and the only vehicles that can temporarily park overnight are for people away on district authorized events or for vehicles that have broken down.
