NEW BUSINESS

Clery Statistics Presentation - 2018

Chief Trevis gave a preview of the Clery Act statistics that will be submitted to the Department of Education (ED) on October 1st. This presentation will also be given to the Cabinet.

Nina explained that the stats are scheduled to be submitted to the ED by this Friday and will be emailed to the campus community on Monday. Printed copies will also be available in select campus division offices.

Her presentation discussed Clery stats for crimes which occurred on campus, on public property contiguous to campus and non-campus locations (i.e. field trips and/or other facilities where classes are held).

Chief continued the presentation by discussing current police officer staffing, gave an AIMS team update and reviewed various police department and quality of life call stats. We tried to compare our stats with other college police agencies and nobody in LA County/So Cal area keeps track of these items as we do.

Quality of life stats include coyote sightings, elevator issues, medical aid, skateboarders and smoking. Chief will look into adding homelessness as a quality of life stat. The good news is many of these incidents do not involve our students but are from non-students who walk on campus, including homeless people, on weekends and holidays. Violence among the homeless in the channel has also increased.
