Admissions and Records

- Faculty Virtual Hours to be held throughout the semester to assist faculty.
- Implemented the statewide ID.me verification information for students to assist the CCCO's with combatting fraudulent applicants that can take seats from real students.
- Began working with more support and cohorted programs to help block-enroll students.
- We continue working on improving the SIS system to better serve the college.

Financial Aid

- Disbursements begin with eligible students receiving funds in hand on 2/9
- Fall 2023 Academic Progress check was completed and for students with substandard grades due to mitigating circumstances are now able to submit an appeal, opened on 2/10

2024-2025 Financial Aid

- Delay for institutions to receive federal and state financial aid records (FAFSA/CA Dream Act): early March Priority filing deadline and/or commitment deadline may change based on each institution
- Students need to check with each institution directly
- For El Camino: Priority financial aid filing deadline remains April 2nd with financial aid file completion by July 1st
- GPA submission for SSN and non-SSN to CSAC for Cal Grant consideration on 1/29/2024; this is for all students who attended from Spring 2022 to Fall 2023 with at least 16 degree applicable units
- Cash for College Event to assist student/family with filing financial aid application: Saturday, February 24 (9:30am to 12:30pm) and Wednesday, March 27 (3pm to 6pm)

Basic Needs

- Hours for the Spring semester have been updated for the Warrior Pantry & Closet, Tuesday, Noon 5:00 p.m.,
 Wednesday, 10:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. Thursday, 10:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. We open later on Tuesday to give our staff time to pick up and clean our weekly produce deliveries in the morning.
- The Basic Needs Center is open Monday Thursday 9:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m. to assist students with advisement and referrals. Our new Warrior Resource Program (WRP) will focus on high need students this term and provide weekly case management and support. Our goal is to serve 125 students with personalized assistance.
- Everytable contract is finalized and we will begin receiving deliveries on Tuesdays each week. The fifty meals we receive will be provided to our homeless students first and the remaining meals will be provided to students at our pantry.
- California Higher Education Basic Needs Alliance (CHEBNA) 2024 Summit February 21 22: The Basic Needs
 Center staff will attend the 2024 CHEBNA Summit next week. Students, staff, faculty and community partners
 will explore the efforts of advancing basic needs security in order to address student success on an individual,
 communal and institutional level.
- The Metro U-Pass invoice for Fall 2023 came in at \$48,039.25 and the BPO with the bookstore is currently being increased to cover the cost. The Metro U-Pass for Spring has dropped from \$101.25 in the fall to \$66.50 so we expect much less cost for the spring.

International Student Program

- ISP welcomed 338 new F1 visa students to the spring 2024 program. This is a 14% increase from spring 2023 with 297 students.
- ECLA begins spring 2024 for their intensive English program on Feb. 20th
- We will begin an international specific Human Development class the 2nd 8 week session taught by the ISP counselor which will walk F1 visa students through specifics of the ISP program and navigating ECC/U.S. education.
- The International Warriors, a group of F1 visa students kicked off the semester with a game night potluck where international students visited and met others in the program
- ISP celebrated two of our students who were a part of the undefeated soccer team the first week of the term

We will be staying in a hotel in San Diego, 15 minutes from our non-profit partners Border Angels, an organization that educates and assists the communities on both sides of the border as an attempt to reduce the number of fatalities along the US-Mexico border. Students will participate in water drops in the desert, interact with day laborers and visit important sites along the border.






