- We are pleased to announce the return of pre-apprenticeships to our work-based learning programming in Spring 2025. This initiative will be in partnership with Northrop Grumman and will focus on the following highdemand occupations:

 Northrop Grumman will prioritize students enrolled in academic programs aligned with these occupations. SOCIAL JUSTICE CENTER "LEADERSHIP IN ACTION"

- Social Justice Center "Leadership in Action" seeks to:
 - o bring together students who are passionate about social justice;
 - give them tools, activities and games to get them thinking collectively about some of society's greatest challenges *Environmental Justice, Housing, Mental Health and Food Justice*;

- We will take students to San Diego, close to the US-Mexico border region for a four-day service and immersion experience working closely with Border Angeles, a non-profit community organization that "advocates for human rights, humane immigration reform, and social justice with a special focus on issues related to the US-Mexican border" (www.borderangels.org/about-us).
- Students will travel out and participate in an array of service projects, discussions, and workshops to immerse themselves with different social, environmental, and economic issues.
- Students will need to enroll in Ethnic Studies 1 (2484) which is an academic course during the Spring 2025 semester.
