- We continue to work with our IT Partners on Colleague and Self -Service to improve services to students and staff
- We continue to Academic Affair Partners on the new 320 reporting coming up as well as the new common course number project
- We continue to work with ECC's Fraudulent Application process
- Work with our Strategic Enrollment Management Team to improve the enrollment process for all
- The Registrar is a member of two statewide committees for Reimagine CCCAPPLY and the transcript RFP helping to improve the application and E-Transcript process for the CCC system.
