- First Pell disbursement: \$2,574,772 for 4,080 students – with clean/completed records
- First Pell Gap disbursement: \$165,217 for 260 students – records in the queue for processing
- Gainful Employment reporting due October 1 – partnership with IRP
- Second Pell disbursement delayed by a few days due to fraud activity

Fraud Activity for first 2 weeks of Fall 2024 term

- 489 student records were reported; records were dropped for no show and/or suspicious activity
- Froze \$161,702 in Pell funds for 207 records
- Reversed \$43,288 in Pell funds
- \$20,743 in Pell funds were disbursed to 26 student records; funds have been reversed and reported as overpayment to Department of Education
