Basic Needs:

- El Camino College will be participating in the Stamp Out Hunger event hosted by the United States Post Office on Saturday, May 11, 2024. This year we will volunteer at the Torrance Post Office to sort donations from local residents. Last year we received over 6 tons of donations in the form of can goods and other non-perishable food donations. We are asking for volunteers to assist us by loading and unloading two trucks at the post office then unloading them at the Basic Needs Center. - Our current Basic Needs unduplicated headcount for Spring 2024 is 1,376 students. As a reminder students are encouraged to utilize Basic Needs as long as they are currently enrolled and have a student ID.
- We are still recruiting students to participate in the Warrior Resource Program as part of a cohort of 125 students who will receive direct service and support weekly from the Basic Needs Center. CalWORKs

- As of 3/21, CalWORKs has 181 students with 3 additional pending
- CalWORKs will continue to accept new intakes as they come in, as there is no cut-off date for CalWORKs onboarding
- Working with our CalWORKs graduate who will be a student speaker at the Student Recognition Ceremony in May
- Offering virtual office hours every Tuesday morning from 9:00 am to 10:00 to assist with questions regarding the completion of GAIN documents and/or concerns
- We have collected 101 Verification of Benefits (VoB) and will continue to contact students who have not submitted them for spring
- CalWORKs Workshop: Interview Skills and Techniques -April 16th 1:00 PM- 2:00 pm via Zoom
- CARE & CalWORKs Parent Appreciation Day: April 23, 4:00 pm to 5:30 PM
- CalWORKs WORK STUDY
 - We have a total of 11 students working on campus. 2 in SDO, 1 at the Contact Center, 1 in EOPS, and 7 at the Warrior Pantry. 1 more student is onboarding with HR to work at the Warrior Pantry, and 2 more students are interviewing for positions.
 - Resume assistance: We are promoting the importance, and the requirement, for all CalWORKs students to have a resume on file with the CalWORKs program. Students can take advantage of receiving a \$40 Pacific Dining meal card if they make an appointment with Karin Baluyot during April to have their resumes updated.
- CHILD CARE – We're in the process of providing temporary childcare for two students for spring break coverage (while school is closed) and during Crystal Stairs intake issues related to the number of children and homelessness.
- We are in the process of checking on students who are eligible for the CW Spring 2024 Grant. We are continuing to add new intakes to the eligible list. The cut-off date will be April 19th, and then we will send the

eligible list to the Financial Aid office for review and disbursement.

Foster Youth Student Success

- Thank you to everyone who came to support the Vision Board event. Students who attended and many staff members learned a lot about Career Services/ Center resources.
- Tabling at Warrior Wellness Fair on 3/27/2024 went well. Four students showed interest and may be eligible for Guardian Scholars or NextUp.
- Foster Youth Student Success team will be visiting Gardena High School on April 10th to give an FYSS presentation.
- Guardian Scholars/NextUp upcoming event on April 18th. We're hosting a Peer Mental Health Support Group in collaboration with Student Health Services.
- Kudos to Lara & Roz for working to build a combined roster integrating student information for Guardian Scholars & NextUp.
- We've streamlined NextUp/Guardian Scholars intake process with specific duties for each team member.
- Currently we have 42 NextUp and 30 Guardian Scholars students. We will continue outreach, recruitment and onboarding of new students.
- We're continuing to provide meal cards to both NextUp and Guardian Scholars students. Students are appreciative of them.
- EOPS application - additional questions were added to screen students for eligibility for both Guardian Scholars and NextUp.

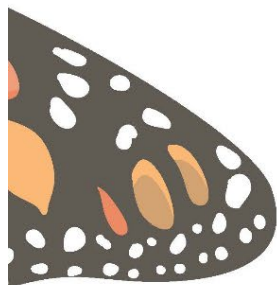

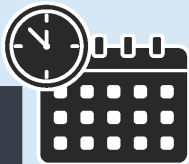

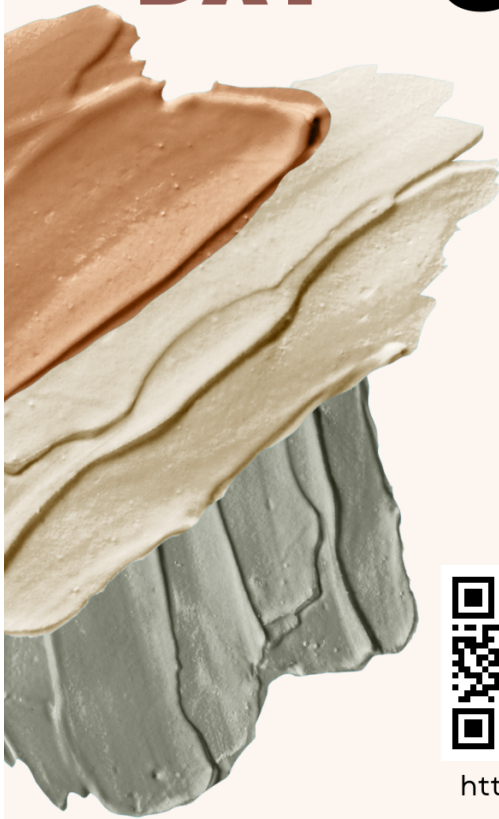
