Basic Needs

- Last month the Basic Needs Center team attended the California Higher Education Basic Needs Alliance 2024 Summit in Sacramento. Topics included legislation related to housing and satisfactory academic progress. We intend to change our SAP Policy effective Fall 2024 to reflect these changes. Training will be offered to staff and faculty over the summer to explain the changes and the process for submitting appeals.
- The Warrior Resource Program is recruiting students to participate as part of a cohort of 125 students who will receive direct service and support weekly from the Basic Needs Center. We are looking to serve students who are currently enrolled and need significant support with food and housing insecurity.
- The Everytable meals are being distributed to students on a weekly basis if they are facing housing insecurity or significant financial challenges. We are now in our fourth week of the program and any meals that are left over on Thursday are given to the Social Justice Center and Library so these students can pick up meals on Friday and the weekend as well. We are thankful for their support and collaboration in serving our students.

CARE

CalWORKs

- As of 2/20, CalWORKs has 170 students enrolled for the Spring 2024 semester. We have 4 additional intake forms to follow through.
- We will continue to add the spring 2024 Verification of Benefits from currently enrolled students.
- March 5th – Final Exit Teleconference to discuss the draft report for the review of ECC District’s Department of Public Social Services CalWORKs Contract. The LA Countywide Contract Monitoring Division completed a contract compliance review of ECCD.
- Scholarship opportunity for students who experience housing insecurity is available. The deadline for students to apply for the \$1,000 a month scholarship is March 14th. We will work with the students to assist with the application process
- March 28th Workshop: Courageous Conversations: Reframing what it Means to be a CalWORKs Student
- Virtual Office Hour remains open on Tuesdays from 9:00 am – 10:00 am
- CalWORKs will continue to accept new intakes as they come in, as there is no cut-off date for CalWORKs onboarding

Foster Youth Student Success (Guardian Scholars & NextUP)

- Guardian Scholars and NextUP hosted their first Welcome Back event together on February 21, 2024 in the Social Justice Center.
- Guardian Scholars currently has 29 actively enrolled students and NextUP currently has 36 actively enrolled students. We are supporting 65 current and former foster youth as part of our Foster Youth Student Success efforts.
- On Wednesday, March 6th from 1pm-2pm Guardian Scholars and NextUp will be hosting their next workshop: Housing Panel w/ Basic Needs and the Department of Children and Family Services.
- Guardian Scholars is in talks to present to high school students at Gardena High School coming mid- to late

March.

- Guardian Scholars and NextUP represented at the Student Support/ Club Expo held in the Student Services Plaza on 2/27/2024.
- We have ordered a new Foster Youth Student Success tent and tablecloth that will include the Guardian Scholars and NextUP logos under the Foster Youth Student Success umbrella.

- Inter-Club Council hosted a successful 2024 Spring Club Rush with over 50 clubs tabling throughout 3 separate days to over 1,000 students and participants total
- Inter-Club Council allocated \$23,340 in total allowances from Club Support to provide financial support for numerous Spring and Fall events that the clubs are planning for
- Inter-Club Council is preparing for Spring Elections to occur May 6th
- Inter-Club Council will host a Movie Night March 28th in East Dining from 5pm-8pm for Students, free of charge

ASO Highlights

- ASO hosted Winter Retreat for all 50+ members, culminating in a Public Art Display to be unveiled in May in the Library and the Communications buildings.
- ASO Election season is in full swing and candidate petitions are due on 3/22. Elections will happen from 4/15-4/17 via Engage
- Hosted over 850 students at Spring Support Expo in collaboration with ICC and Student Development. Thanks to over 60 departments and clubs that held tables.
- ASO hosted over 75 students at the Safety Forum discussing concerns with MarComm and Campus Police.
- ASO funded Taste of Soul, with over 500 participants, as part of Black History Month.
- ASO transitioned to Board Docs, to create further accessibility to meeting contents and minutes.
- ASO Funding Summary (approvals since January 15)
 - Over \$100,000 allocated across campus, departments, internally, and towards events since January for FY 23-24
 - Executed 3-year contract extension of ECC Engage - Campus Engagement Platform that features all clubs, finances, department pages, and more, with grand expansion plans of its utilization across staff, faculty, and students.
- ASO has elected to move away from Flo-Water as it currently stands, with ideas for replacement, renewal, or other companies forthcoming.
