- 1) Monitor campus climate and race and equity
- 2) Review and monitor student success, equity and progress including any gaps among student groups

- 4) Promote and support initiatives to foster and support a student-centered culture meeting the needs of El Camino stakeholders and all cities and communities served by the district
- 5) Monitor and review updates and reports on campus safety and security and seek policy and funding solutions to close any gaps
